Subject: Sanction for purchase of 05 (Five) units of vehicles along with advance drawl of funds in favor of Director General Family Welfare, MCH & Immunization, J&K.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the:

- a. purchase of 05 (Five) units of vehicles for immunization purpose as replacement against condemned vehicles in favor of Director General, Family Welfare, MCH & Immunization, J&K in relaxation of the austerity measures imposed vide Govt. order No. 321-F of 2021 dated 06.12.2021.
- b. advance drawl of funds amounting to ₹ 47.00 lakhs (Rupees forty seven lakhs only) by Director General, Family Welfare, MCH & Immunization, J&K out of the available funds under Revenue Budget 2021-22 under classification 2211 - 00 - 101 - 0099 - 2204 - Director Family Welfare, Detailed Head 046- Purchase of Vehicle, already released through BEAMS for the financial year 2021-22.

The sanction shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The vehicles shall be purchased through Motor Garages Department.
2. No post of driver shall be created.
3. The vehicles shall be used exclusively for the purpose of immunization only in both the divisions of Jammu & Kashmir.
4. The Chief Accounts Officer, Directorate of Family Welfare, MCH & Immunization, J&K shall vouchsafe the availability of funds under relevant detailed head.
5. All codal formalities for affecting the purchase shall be adhered to.
6. UC's / Red DC Account of the advance drawl shall be furnished to the concerned quarters including A.G within stipulated time.


