- (i) The officers shall have no superior claim over their seniors for consideration for promotion after acquiring higher/additional qualification.
- (ii) The stipend, scholarship etc, if any, received during study leave is adjusted in their leave salary.
- (iii) The officers have completed their period of probation satisfactorily.

- (iv) Total study leave availed by these officers shall not exceed (03) years in each case during their entire service.
- (v) The doctors can be spared during the COVID-19 pandemic.
