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**Subject: Release of Funds under Centrally Sponsored Scheme "National Health Mission" during the year 2021-22.**

**Government Order No: 173 - JK (HME) of 2022**

**Dated: 30 -03-2022**

In continuation to Govt. Order No.91-JK(HME) of 2022 dated 21-02-2022 and Govt. Order No. 146-JK (HME) of 2022 dated. 22-03-2022, sanction is hereby accorded to the:-

1. Release of Rs. 6.14 lakhs (Rupees six lakhs fourteen thousand) only as grant-in-aid sanctioned by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India under Centrally Sponsored Scheme "National Health Mission" and its placement at the disposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission, J&K for its utilization towards the approved components of the scheme during the current financial year 2021-22.
2. Advance drawl of Rs. 6.14 lakhs (Rupees six lakhs fourteen thousand) only, by Mission Director, National Health Mission, J&K for e-transfer of the amount into State Nodal Account (SNA) of J&K State Health Society enabling utilization of these funds during the current financial year 2021-22 as per the revised procedure of CSS Funds notified by the Ministry of Finance, GoI on 23-03-2021 read with other SOPs/ guidelines duly circulated by the Finance Department from time to time.

The release of funds shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The expenditure shall be made strictly, according to the classification under which funds have been authorized by the Finance Department.
2. Treasury Officers shall not entertain bills without complete classification under which funds have been authorized by the Finance Department.
3. Drawing and Disbursing Officer (DDO) shall complete all codal formalities before presentation of bills at the Treasury.
4. Treasury Officer shall not allow parking or drawl of funds in the Civil Deposit without prior concurrence of the Finance Department.
5. Mission Director, NHM shall send status report about the scheme in terms of physical and financial progress made during the current financial year.
6. Mission Director, NHM shall send Utilization Certificate (UC) of the funds as early as possible and positively before 31-03-2022 to Govt. of India under intimation to this department.
7. All the sanctions/ approvals and clearances shall be in place before drawl of money from the treasury.
8. Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department shall vouchsafe the availability of funds on BEAMS portal and accordingly release the funds to the concerned.

9. The expenditure shall be incurred strictly as per the guidelines of the scheme and the conditions laid down in the sanction letter of the concerned ministry of Government of India.
10. The funds shall not be available for re-appropriation/ diversion at any level.


