Subject: Initiation of Regular Departmental Action against Dr. Deepak Kapoor, the then Medical Officer, Epidemiology, Jammu for commission of offences punishable under section 5 (1) (d) r/w 5 (2) of the J&K Prevention of Corruption Act, Samvat 2006 and 120-B RPC in case FIR No 19/2011 P/S VOJ

WHEREAS, the General Administration Department vide Government Order No. 8-GAD(Vig.) of 2017 dated 06.02.2017 and in pursuance of section 6 of Jammu and Kashmir Prevention of Corruption Act, Samvat 2006, accorded sanction for the prosecution of Dr. Deepak Kapoor Medical Officer, Epidemiology Jammu commissioning of the offences punishable under section 5(1) (d) r/w 5(2) of the Jammu and Kashmir Prevention of Corruption Act, Samvat 2006 and 120-B RPC in case FIR NO. 19/2011 P/S Vigilance Organization, Jammu and advised the Health and Medical Education Department to initiate Regular Departmental Action against the doctor;

AND WHEREAS, the case was examined in the department and vide O.M. No. HME/HRM/21/2017 dated 18.07.2017, Memorandum, Article of Charges & Statement of Imputations was served to Dr. Deepak Kapoor, the then Medical Officer, Epidemiology, Jammu in terms of J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956;

AND WHEREAS, in response to the Charge sheet, the reply/statement of defence submitted by Dr. Deepak Kapoor was forwarded to this department by Director Health Services, Jammu vide letter No. DHS/CS/5266 dated 12.08.2017;

AND WHEREAS, the reply submitted by Dr. Deepak Kapoor was examined in the department and it was decided to enquire into the matter by appointing an Inquiry Officer;

AND WHEREAS, vide Government Order No. 38-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 14.01.2021 read with Government Order No. 479-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 08.07.2021, Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department was appointed as Inquiry Officer in terms of sub-rule 4 of Rule (33) of the J&K Civil Services (Classification,



Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956 to conduct a detailed enquiry into the charges framed against Dr. Deepak Kapoor;

AND WHEREAS, vide O.M. No. HME/DF/PS/5/2021 dated 20.12.2021, the Inquiry Officer has furnished the enquiry report and on examining the report and available records, it reveals that the charges leveled against the Doctor are found to be baseless and not proved;

AND WHEREAS, the enquiry report was examined in the department and it emerged that the charges leveled against Dr. Deepak Kapoor found to be baseless and the matter was placed before the competent authority who has accepted the closure of the case.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the recommendations of the Inquiry Officer and approval of the competent authority, it is hereby ordered that the charges leveled against Dr. Deepak Kapoor, the then Medical Officer, Epidemiology Jammu are hereby dropped and the departmental enquiry against him is accordingly closed.


