Subject:- Termination of Services of Dr Naiyma Choudhary, Assistant Professor, Department of Pharmacology, GMC Kathua.

Reference:- GMCK/Admn/2021-22/4530-34 dated.25.09.2021 from Principal, Government Medical College, Kathua.

Government Order No. 351 - JK(HME) of 2022

WHEREAS, on the recommendation of J&K Public Service Commission, Dr Naiyma Choudhary was appointed as Assistant Professor in the Department of Pharmacology, Government Medical College Kathua vide Government Order No. 615-HME of 2018 dated 26.10.2018;

AND WHEREAS, Dr Naiyma Choudhary after joining her duties in Government Medical College, Kathua proceeded on 30 days Child Care leave w.e.f 30.03.2021 to 28.04.2021;

AND WHEREAS, the Principal, GMC Kathua vide Order dated 10.04.2021 cancelled all kinds of leaves in view of surge of COVID pandemic. However, Dr. Naiyma Choudhary failed to join her duties back in GMC Kathua;

AND WHEREAS, the Principal, Government Medical College, Kathua on 02.06.2021, served a show cause notice to Dr. Naiyma Choudhary directing her to join her duties by or before 6th June 2021, failing which it shall be presumed that she is not interested to continue her job;

AND WHEREAS, the Principal, GMC, Kathua on 09.09.2021 served another notice to Dr. Naiyma Choudhary with the directions to resume her duties within a period of seven (07) days from the date of issuance of the notice, otherwise, action warranted under rules shall be initiated against her;

AND WHEREAS, the Principal, GMC Kathua vide communication dated 25.09.2021 reported that Dr. Naiyma Choudhary neither responded to the notice nor reported back to her duties and accordingly, recommended her case to the Administrative Department for necessary action as warranted under rules against the absconding doctor;

AND WHEREAS, the case was examined in the Health & Medical Education Department and it was felt that before taking action as warranted under Service Rules against Dr. Nayima Choudhary, Principal, GMC Kathua vide this Department's letter dated 02.12.2021 was advised to issue a final notice to the absconding doctor to be published in a leading local daily at Jammu, asking her to resume her duties within a period of seven (07) days positively, failing which action as warranted under rules shall be initiated against her;

AND WHEREAS, the Principal, GMC Kathua vide communication dated 22.12.2021 reported that on 10.12.2021, a final notice was served to Dr Naiyma Choudhary with the directions to join back the office for further duties within seven (07) days from the publication of notice through print media (Daily Excelsior, State Observer, Refugee Message). However, the absconding doctor didn't join her duties in the Department;

AND WHEREAS, the case has been examined in light Article 128 of the Jammu & Kashmir, Civil Service Regulations, 1956 and it has been observed that Dr Naiyma Choudhary had remained unauthorizedly absent from her duties and has, therefore, lost her service in view of the import and purport of Article 128 of the Jammu & Kashmir, Civil Service Regulation;

Now, therefore, the services of **Dr Naiyma Choudhary, Assistant Professor in the discipline of Pharmacology, Government Medical College, Kathua, D/O Mohd Akram Choudhary R/O 52 Gujjar Colony Channi Himmat** are terminated with immediate effect.
