Subject: Unauthorized absence of doctor – joining thereof.

Government Order No. 166-JK(HME) of 2023

WHEREAS, Dr. Amrit Rai Badgal was appointed as Medical Officer vide Government Order No. 132-HME of 2014 dated 04.03.2014;

AND WHEREAS, vide letter No. HD/Gaz/Gen/ 198/2019 dated 10.08.2020, among others, approval for grant of NOC/permission for applying/ appearing/ counseling before NBE/NEET or any authorized forum was conveyed in favour of Dr. Amrit Rai Badgal, Medical Officer;

AND WHEREAS, after selection of the above said doctor for DNB Orthopedic Surgery at Government Multi Specialty Hospital, Chandigarh for a period of two years, Director, Health Services, Kashmir, vide communication No. DHS/J/ES-3/6130/2315 dated 13.10.2020, forwarded his study leave case in the Administrative Department w.e.f. 31.07.2020;

AND WHEREAS, the study leave case of doctor has been taken up with the Finance Department and is under consideration;

AND WHEREAS, Director, Health Services, Jammu vide communication No. ES-3/6130/3902 dated 16.08.2022 has informed that Dr. Amrit Rai Badgal, Medical Officer after completion of his DNB in Orthopedics, from Government Multi-Specialty Hospital, Chandigarh, has submitted his joining report in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu on 18.07.2022 and requested to consider the request of the doctor favourably;

AND WHEREAS, Dr. Amrit Rai Badgal, Medical Officer has shown his willingness to rejoin his duties, therefore, the Government has taken a lenient view in his case and decided to accept his joining

report.




NOW, THEREFORE, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

a) accept the joining report of Dr. Amrit Rai Badgal, Medical Officer notionally w.e.f. 18.07.2022 and monetary with immediate effect, subject to following conditions:-:-

i. He was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any other Government/private sector during the said period, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir.

ii. The concerned doctor is warned not to leave his place of posting for any occasion whatsoever in future, without proper permission from the competent authority, failing which, disciplinary action in terms of Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services Regulations Volume-I shall be initiated against him without any further notice.

b) The period of undergone DNB in Orthopedic from Government Multi-Specialty Hospital Chandigarh by the aforesaid doctor shall be decided by the Departmental Designated Committee, separately after the decision of his study leave case is taken.
