In pursuance of SO 22 of 2019 dated 03-12-2019, sanction is hereby accorded to the grant of LTC in favour of Dr. Shashi Sudhan, Secretary (Technical), H&ME Department for the block 2020-23 to visit Ranchi, Jharkhand wef 11-12-2023 to 20-12-2023 along with her husband.

The sanction shall be subject to following conditions:

4. An entry shall be made in the service book of the doctor as prescribed under Rule 16(1) and 16(2) of the J&K Civil Services (LTC) Rules, 2019;
5. The final LTC claim on the form 3 shall be submitted to the head of the office within one month from the date of return journey;
6. The entitlement is regulated by the concerned DDO under rules;
7. The dependence of family members of the officer is established under rules;
8. The journey is undertaken by the shortest possible route.
