4. Eligibility of candidates for admission to the above Courses shall be made on merit basis as per the previous laid down by the Government from time to time through J&K Board of Professional Mut Entrance Examination.

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5. The J&K Paramedical Council shall conduct inspection of the institute, periodically, to monitor and excess the adequacy of infrastructure in relation to the number of trainees.

- 6. An amount of Rs. 5000/- per trainee per session be charged by the institute on account of providing hospital facility and the amount so received be utilized for Hospital Development fund of the Hospital to which the institute is attached.
