**WHEREAS**, the Health & Medical Education Department received several representations from the aspirants, who have completed their Senior Residency from Government Medical Colleges of J&K and requested for considering them eligible for the posts of Assistant Professor in the discipline of Dentistry in new Government Medical Colleges of J&K; and

**WHEREAS**, following is the method or recruitment and qualification prescribed for the post of Assistant Professor in the discipline of Dentistry in new Government Medical Colleges of J&K, prescribed vide SO 284 of 2021 dated 18.08.2021, SO 285 of 2021 dated 18.08.2021, SO 286 of 2021 dated 18.08.2021, SO 287 of 2021 dated 18.08.2021, SO 288 of 2021 dated 18.08.2021, Government Order No. 672-JK(HME) of 2022 dated 19.09.2022 & 673-JK(HME) of 2022 dated 19.09.2022:

**WHEREAS**, the representations of the aspirants have been examined in the Health & Medical Education Department and it has been found



that candidates possessing MDS Degree and having Teaching Experience as Senior Resident/ Registrar/ Tutor from Medical/Dental Colleges are eligible for the post of Assistant Professor. However, the recruitment rules of new GMCs prescribed by the Health & Medical Education Department do not mention Teaching/ Research experience as Registrar/ Tutor/ Demonstrator or as a Senior Resident from an Institution duly recognized/permitted by the National Medical Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, candidates possessing a minimum two (02) years Teaching/ Research experience as Registrar/ Tutor/ Demonstrator or as a Senior Resident in the discipline of Dentistry, after post-graduation, from an Institution duly recognized/permitted by the Dental Council of India/ National Medical Commission shall be considered for the posts of Assistant Professor in the discipline of Dentistry in new Government Medical Colleges of J&K.
