- e. The Director, Ayush, J&K shall send status report about the scheme in terms of physical and financial progress made during the current financial year.
- f. The Director, Ayush, J&K shall send Utilization Certificate (UC) of the funds as early as possible and positively before 31-03-2024 to Govt. of India in the prescribed format under intimation to this department.



g. All the sanctions/ approvals and clearances shall be in place before drawl of

money from the treasury.

h. Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department shall vouchsafe the availability of funds on BEAMS portal and accordingly release the funds to the concerned.

i. The expenditure shall be incurred strictly as per the guidelines of the scheme and the conditions laid down in the sanction letter of the concerned Ministry of Government of India.

j. The funds shall not be available for re-appropriation/ diversion at any level.

k. All conditions as contained in BEAMS Generated order be adhered in letter & spirit.
