

Subject: Consideration order in compliance to order dated 16.09.2016 passed in MP 01/2015 in SWP No. 2054/2015 titled Rajni Sharma V/S State & others.

Government Order No. 1076-JK (HME) of 2023 Dated: 20-12-2023

Whereas, on the recommendations of JKSSB, Smt. Rajni Sharma was appointed as Jr. Staff Nurse vide Order No. 16/AHJ of 1995 dated 06.02.1995 issued by Principal, Government Medical College, Jammu and vide Order No. 361/AHJ of 2004 dated 01.09.2004, she was placed as Incharge Public Health Nurse (PHN) Tutor. On the recommendations of DPC (Non-Gazetted), she was regularized on the said post w.e.f. 14.12.2007 vide Order No. 104/AHJ of 2008 dated 07.05.2008; and

Whereas, vide Government Order No. 677-HME of 2012 dated 09.11.2012, Smt. Rajni Sharma, PHN Tutor was ordered to look after the duties of Principal, AMT School, Jammu, till the post is filled through regular process. The petitioner has also been paid charge allowance for the said period; and

Whereas, Smt. Rajni Sharma in the meantime sought regularization on the post of Principal, AMT School and towards that end filed a writ petition bearing SWP No. 2054/2015 titled Rajni Sharma vs State & Ors before the Hon'ble High Court; and

Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court vide interim order dated 16.09.2016 passed in MP 01/2015 in SWP No. 2054/2015 titled Smt. Rajni Sharma vs State & Ors directed as under:

"Petitioner is continuing as Incharge Principal AMT School, Jammu in terms of Government Order No. 829-HME of 2015 dated 31.12.2015. The Government has released the charge allowance in favour of the petitioner as permissible under rules for having discharged her services against the post of Principal, AMT School Jammu. It is submitted that the services of similarly situated Principal- Halima Akhter placed as Incharge Principal, AMT School Srinagar in her own pay and grade vide order No. 438-HME of 2011 have been regularized on the recommendation of PSC/DPC vide Government Order No. 621-HME of 2013 dated 02.12.2013.

Prima facie, it appears that respondents have unnecessarily withheld the benefit of regularization in favour of the petitioner. In the circumstances, this application is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to confirm the petitioner as Principal, AMT School Jammu with effect from 09.11.2012 in accordance with Rule 7 (1) of J&K Medical Education (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 1979. Consideration shall be effected and decision taken on the similar lines as has been done in case of Halima Akhter expeditiously within a period of two months".

Whereas, in the meantime the case got transferred to Central Administrative Tribunal Jammu Bench wherein the case has been registered as T.A. No. 8534/2021; and

Whereas, the method of promotion and the step-wise mode of promotion and feeding cadres for the post of Principal AMT School is two-fold in terms of J&K Medical Education (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 1979 and Government Order No. 26-HME of 2006 dated 19-01-2006 which is reproduced as under:

Whereas, in terms of Sub Rule (1) of rule 18 of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services, Decentralization and Recruitment Rules 2010 provides as under: -

"...Promotions to the gazette posts shall be made in accordance with rules governing such posts and on the recommendations of Public Service Commission/ Departmental Promotion Committee."

Whereas, in pursuance of the Hon'ble High Court directions, the regularization case of Smt. Rajni Sharma was submitted to JKPSC vide letter dated 23.05.2019. In response, the JKPSC vide communication dated 10.10.2019 returned the proposal with the observation that as per the provisions of the J&K Medical Education (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 1979, Nursing Superintendent/ Principal Tutor is the feeding cadre for the post of Principal, AMT School; and

Whereas, the case of the petitioner has been accordingly reexamined and it has been observed that the applicant has been placed on the post of Principal, AMT School, bye-passing several steps of hierarchy through which she had to mandatorily pass for promotion to the post of Principal as is evident from the table above. The petitioner has not been promoted as Sister Tutor and then Principal Tutor which is the feeding cadre to the post of Principal and in order to regularize her on the post of Principal, AMT School, Jammu, she must be promoted on the post of Sister Tutor and then Principal Tutor in the first instance and, thereafter, she can be promoted on the post of Principal, AMT School. However, to settle the case, vide this Department's letter dated 04.07.2022, Principal, Government Medical College, Jammu was requested to furnish the vacancy position of Sister Tutor w.e.f. 01.09.2009 and Principal



Tutor w.e.f. 01.09.2014 and in response, Principal, Government Medical College, Jammu has reported that Smt. Rajni Sharma has been promoted as PHN Tutor and the post of Sister Tutor has been vacant from 2009-10 till ending December, 2014; however the post of Principal Tutor is not available; and

Whereas, vide Government Order No. 765-JK(HME) of 2022 dated 28.10.2022, Smt. Rajni Sharma has been promoted as Sister Tutor, AMT School, Jammu (Government Medical College, Jammu), notionally w.e.f. 01.09.2009, however, she cannot be promoted to the post of Principal Tutor due to non-availability of post and lack of five (05) years of actual teaching experience as Sister Tutor or equivalent; and

Whereas, once the petitioner cannot be promoted as Principal Tutor, which is one of the feeding cadre for the post of Nursing Superintendent/Principal, she cannot, therefore, be promoted as Principal; and

Whereas, in light of guidelines laid down in compliance to Suraj Prakash Gupta Vs State and Ors Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the promotion has to take effect from the date of placement on higher post or eligibility or availability of vacancy, whichever is later. However, in case of the petitioner, neither the vacancy is available nor has she acquired the eligibility, therefore, she cannot be promoted on higher posts.

Now, therefore, the claim of the petitioner seeking promotion to the post of Principal AMT School (Government Medical College, Jammu) has been considered in compliance to interim order dated 16.09.2016 passed in MP 01/2015 in SWP No. 2054/2015 titled Rajni Sharma V/S State & others and in light of rules in vouge and eligibility and found devoid of any merit and, hence, rejected.
