

In terms to Rule 61(1), Rule 62(a) & Rule 73(1) of the J&K Civil Service (Leave) Rules, 1979 read with SRO-346 dated 17.10.2012 & SRO-274 dated 30.05.2013, sanction is, hereby, accorded to the grant of study leave in favour of Dr. Shahid Matloob, Medical Officer, NTPHC Gopalpora, Block Achabal, Anantnag for undergoing Post MBBS DNB (Obstt. & Gynae.) in Government Medical College, Udhampur for a period of one year in the first instance, from the date of commencement of the course.

However, this shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The work load on account of his study leave is managed through internal arrangement;
- ii. That the doctor shall have no superior claim over his seniors for consideration for promotion after acquiring higher qualification;
- iii. The course undertaken is purely in public interest and shall prove beneficial to the Department;
- iv. The doctor shall submit the certificate of examination of 1st year passed before the Administrative Department prior to seeking extension in study leave;
- v. That the stipend, scholarship etc., if any, received by the doctor during study leave is adjusted in his salary and;
- vi. The doctor shall execute a bond in Form-6, in terms of the Rule 64(3) of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Leave) Rules, 1979.
- vii. In case the said doctor abandons his study leave midway, he shall be subject to the following penalties:-
 - a. withholding of two increments.
 - b. Imposition of penalty to the tune of Rs. 2.0 lacs alongwith recovery of total amount paid to the delinquent doctor during the training of said course.
 - c. Ban from future participation in Government-sponsored educational programs or training courses for a period of 5 years.



Besides, the said doctor is **warned** not to leave the course mid-way otherwise disciplinary proceedings as warranted under rules shall be initiated against him without any further notice.


