The appointment of the aforesaid candidates shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- a) The appointee(s) shall submit his/her joining report physically to the concerned Drawing and Disbursing Officers(DDO) within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of this order and in case of failure of any appointee to join within the stipulated period, his/her appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without any further notice.
- b) The appointees shall be allowed to join by the concerned Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDOs) only on production of the following certificates in original:-
- i. Academic / Qualification Certificates.
- ii. Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate.
- iii. Health Certificate from the concerned Chief Medical Officer of the District.
- iv. Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- v. Valid relevant category certificate, if any applicable.

The appointment of the above candidates shall further be subject to the following conditions :

- **a)** Each appointee shall give an undertaking in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that if on verification, his/her qualification/date of Birth/Reserved Category Certificates from the concerned Issuing authorities is found fake/forged, his/her appointment as Medical Officer(Unani) in the Health and Medical Education Department shall be deemed to have been canceled ab-initio and legal action, as warranted under rules, shall be initiated against him/her.
- b) That if the candidate has taken loan for self-employment from DIC/Employment Department, to be ascertained form the District Industries Centre (DIC) and District Employment and Counseling Centre of the domicile District, he/she shall relinquish the proprietorship of Unit /Enterprise and also stakes, if any, in such self employment Unit / Enterprise before joining the Government Service. He/she shall be required to repay the entire loan liability in suitable EMIs to be worked out by the DDO concerned from his/her salary. DDO concerned shall obtain an affidavit from the concerned appointee regarding both relinquishment of proprietorship and stakes, if any, in such a self-employment unit/enterprise and recovery to be made and also personally monitor its recovery.

- **c)** The salary of the appointees shall not be drawn and disbursed to them unless satisfactory reports in respect of genuineness of Qualification/Date birth/Relevant category certificate are received from the concerned Authorities/Agency.
 - d) The appointees shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- e) The appointment of the candidates shall be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" as notified vide SRO-400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009.
- **f)** The inter-se seniority of the appointees shall be determined as per JKPSC Merit and the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956 and notified separately.
- **g**) The appointee(s) shall not be allowed to continue with PG or any other higher study course/training etc. and they will have only one choice either to opt for appointment or go for such higher study/training course.
- h) The appointment of the candidates shall be subject to outcome of the writ petition (s), if any, pending before any Competent Court(s) of Law.
- i) The appointees shall give an undertaking duly attested by the First Class Judicial Magistrate in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that:
 - He/She shall abide by all the terms & conditions as laid down in this appointment order.
 - ii. He/She is not undergoing any higher study/training course viz. PG/etc and in case after joining as Medical Officer, it comes to the notice of the department that appointee is on the rolls of any Medical College (Government/Private) within or outside the UT of J&K, he/she shall be liable for criminal proceedings under relevant provisions of law and his/her appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio.
 - iii. he/she shall not claim for any kind of leave, permission or exception to continue with his/her higher study/training course viz. PG.etc
 - iv. he/she shall be liable for action as warranted under rules for violating any of the laid down conditions in this appointment order.

It is further ordered that:-

All the District Ayush Officers /Medical Superintendents shall ensure that appointee Medical Officers shall attend duties as per his/her specific place of posting without any change/alteration in their postings by way of deployments or internal arrangements failing which disciplinary proceedings shall be initiated against such concerned District Ayush Officers/ Medical Superintendents/ DDO's including appointee Medical Officer.
