Sanction is hereby accorded to the:

1. release of 10% UT share pertaining to 2021-22 along with advance drawl of funds amounting to ₹ 16.15 lakhs (Rupees sixteen lakhs fifteen thousand only) in favor of Commissioner Food and Drugs Administration, Drugs and Food Control Organization, J&K for the CSS scheme "**Strengthening of Food Safety Eco-system**" during the current financial year 2023-24 for crediting the said amount in the SNA account for its utilization as per the new procedure for release of CSS funds.
2. converting the existing Current Bank Account into SNA account opened under CSS scheme "Strengthening of Food Safety Eco-system" as per the terms and conditions stipulated by Finance Department vide their U.O No. FD-VII- 17(172)CD&FC/2015-16-I dated 24-12-2020 read with U.O No. FD-BDGTOD-17/32/2021-03-FD dated 18-07-2023.

The release/ advance drawl of the funds shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. That the Accounts Officer, Commissioner Food and Drugs Administration, J&K shall vouchsafe the availability of funds.
2. That Red DC Account / Utilization Certificate of the funds being released shall be furnished to all the concerned quarters including Accountant General, J&K.
3. That all codal formalities shall be fulfilled while incurring expenditure against the said advance drawl.

4. The funds shall be utilized for the approved projects / schemes only for which prior Administrative approval and Technical Sanction has been obtained from the competent authority.
5. The funds shall be utilized for execution of the scheme strictly as per the originally approved components and according to GoI's prescribed guidelines.
