- iii. That all other relevant conditions as laid down in Study Leave Rules are strictly adhered to,
- iv. That on completion of course, the applicant shall submit the certificate of examination passed or special courses of study undertaken, indicated the date of commencement and termination of the course to the Principal GMC, Jammu
- v. That a period entry of Study Leave is made in the service Book of the official.
