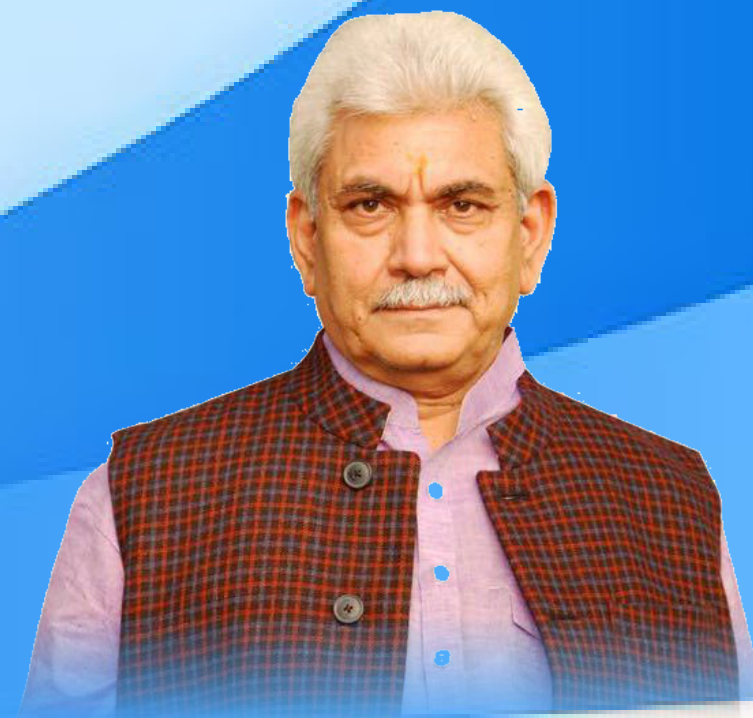

B.Sc Nursing seats increased to 2090 and 1580 B.Sc Paramedical seats available (including Private Medical Colleges) .

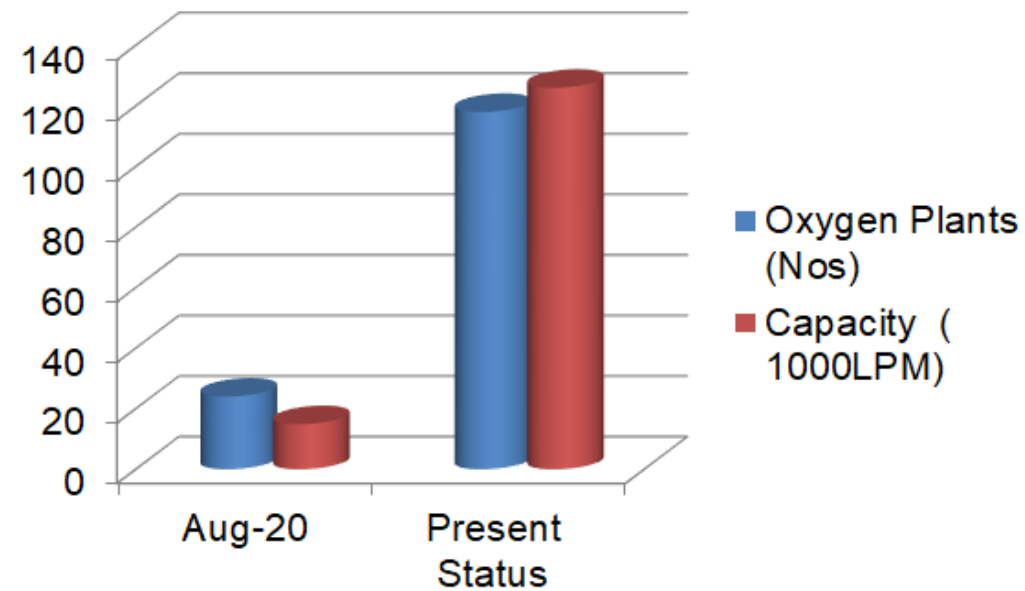

Telemedicine: Enabling patients talk to doctors and get tested remotely using technology.



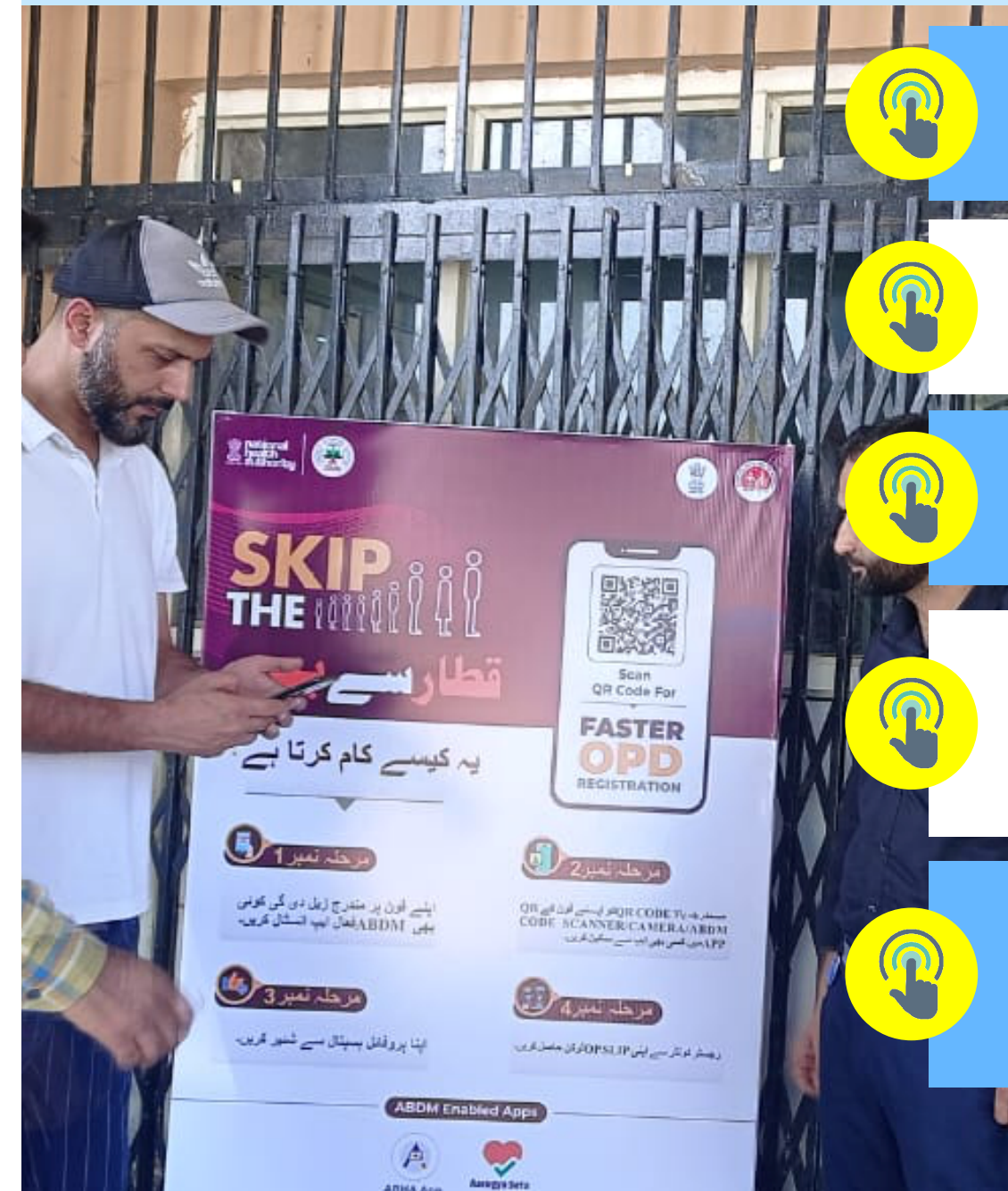
Scan and Share initiative for Digital Patient Queue Management in J&K recognized in frontrunner category at National level .

J&K, received the Award and Certificate for 1st Position in State Food Safety Index 2022-23 for 3rd consecutive year, (received the aforesaid distinction also in the Financial Year 2020-21, 2021-22) among the UT Category. The award was received from the Union Health Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, on 7th June 2023 the eve of World Food Safety Day.

As a significant step towards strengthening public healthcare scenario in J&K, 315 seats have been sanctioned by National Board of Examinations in Medical Science (NBEMS) under DNB for the public Health institutions of J&K.
