Subject:- Settlement of unauthorized absence/undecided period in respect of Dr. Nazia Anjum, Medical Officer.

WHEREAS, Dr. Nazia Anjum was appointed as Medical Officer in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No.335-HME of 2010 dated 17.06.2010 and submitted her joining report in Directorate of Health Services, Jammu on 22.06.2010 and was posted at SDH, Surankote vide Directorate of Health Services, Jammu order No. 412-G of 2010 dated 17.10.2010;

AND WHEREAS, subsequently, the aforesaid doctor was posted at Lalla Ded Hospital Srinagar on deputation basis for a period of one year vide Government Order No. 497-HME of 2014 dated 09.08.2014, thereafter, she was posted at Gousia Hospital, Khanyar for a period of two years vide Government Order No. 361-HME of 2015 dated 31.08.2015. The aforesaid doctor while posted at Gousia Hospital Srinagar applied for sixty days child care leave w.e.f 22.07.2017 which was sanctioned in her favour vide Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir Office Order No. 326-Gz of 2017 dated 25.09.2017 and thereafter restored to un-authorized absence w.e.f 27.09.2017 to 22.07.2018;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department vide communication No. HD/Gaz/Gen/225/2002 dated 23.07.2018 authorized Director, Health Services, Jammu to post the doctor in Jammu division and vide DHSJ order No. 867-G of 2018 dated 10.08.2018, the said doctor was posted at District Tuberculosis Centre, Rajouri;

AND WHEREAS, the said Directorate has forwarded her case of unauthorized absence w.e.f 27.09.2017 to 22.07.2018 to the Administrative Department for further instructions;

AND WHEREAS, Directorate of Health Services, Jammu has forwarded the case of doctor regarding settlement of unauthorised absence period w.e.f 27.09.2017 to 22.07.2018 to the Administrative Department;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department had already constituted Departmental Committee for examining such cases vide Government Order No. 511-HME of 2018 dated 13.09.2018 read with Government Order No. 726-HME of 2018 dated 21.12.2018 & Government Order No. 479-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 08.07.2021. Later on the Health and Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 749-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 30.11.2021, re-constituted the Departmental Committee to be headed by Director Finance, H&ME Department for examining the cases of doctors or any officer/official of sub-ordinate office related to unauthorized absence/ overstay on deputation/ study leave or any other case of similar nature;

AND WHEREAS, the case of Dr. Nazia Anjum, Medical Officer, among others was placed before the Departmental Designated Committee for examination, wherein after series of meetings held w.e.f. 13.12.2021 to 15.12.2021 deliberated upon the matter and recommended as under:

- i. The Committee recommends to treat the period w.e.f 27.09.2017 to 22.07.2018 as leave whatever kind due including child care leave and remaining period if any, shall be treated as Dies-Non in terms of Article 163 of J&K Civil Services Regulations, 1956 by taking administrative decision in the matter and also subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as she was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no Departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor.

Besides, the concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.

Now therefore, the Department while taking considerate view in the matter as per recommendations of the Committee & in the interest of patient care, accords sanction as under :-

- i. to treat the period w.e.f 27.09.2017 to 22.07.2018 as leave whatever kind due including child care leave and remaining period if any, shall be treated as Dies-Non subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as she was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no Departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall

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be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor.

Besides, the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.


