
WHEREAS, Dr. Abdul Roof was appointed as Medical Officer in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No. 335-HME of 2010 dated 17.06.2010 and submitted his joining report in Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir on 18.06.2010;



AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor while posted in Labour department on deputation was selected for MD in SPM at Government Medical College, Srinagar;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department vide letter No. HD/Gaz/Gen-50/2016 dated 01.06.2016 conveyed approval for relieving of the aforesaid doctor to undertake the P.G Course. Thereafter, vide Government Order No. 392-HME of 2017 dated 26.07.2017, among others, sanction was accorded to the grant of study leave for a period of two years w.e.f. 03.06.2016 in favour of the aforesaid doctor. However, remaining one year of study leave was not sanctioned due to unknown reasons w.e.f. 03.06.2018 to 30.07.2019;

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor after completion of P.G course joined in Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir on 31.07.2019 and was posted in Government Medical College, Anantnag on inter-cadre deputation vide Government Order No. 803-HME of 2019 dated 03.09.2019;

AND WHEREAS, Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir has forwarded the case of Dr. Abdul Roof, Medical Officer regarding settlement of period for undergoing P.G Course at Government Medical College,

Srinagar w.e.f. 03.06.2018 to 30.07.2019 (i.e. remaining one year of study leave) to the Administrative Department;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department had already constituted Departmental Committee for examining such cases vide Government Order No. 511-HME of 2018 dated 13.09.2018 read with Government Order No. 726-HME of 2018 dated 21.12.2018 & Government Order No. 479-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 08.07.2021. Later on the Health and Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 749-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 30.11.2021, re-constituted the Departmental Committee to be headed by Director Finance, H&ME Department for examining the cases of doctors or any officer/official of sub-ordinate office related to unauthorized absence/ overstay on deputation/ study leave or any other case of similar nature;


AND WHEREAS, the instant case of Dr. Abdul Roof, Medical Officer, among others was placed before the Departmental Committee for examination, wherein after series of meetings held w.e.f. 13.12.2021 to 15.12.2021 deliberated upon the matter and recommended as under:-

*The Committee recommends to treat the remaining period of MD i.e. one year of study leave period for higher studies in Government Medical College, Srinagar, w.e.f. 03.06.2018 to 30.07.2019 in favour of Dr. Abdul Roof, Medical Officer as leave whatever kind due except study leave and balance period, if any, shall be treated as Dies-Non in terms of Article 163 of J&K Civil Services Regulations, 1956 and also subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities and was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor.*

*Besides, the concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave his place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.*

Now therefore, the Department while taking considerate view in the matter as per recommendations of Committee & in the interest of patient care, accords sanction as under:-

- i. to treat the period during which Dr. Abdul Roof, Medical Officer was undergoing MD in SPM at GMC, Srinagar w.e.f. 03.06.2018 to 30.07.2019 shall be treated as leave whatever kind due except study leave and balance period, if any, shall be



treated as Dies-Non subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities and was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor.

Besides, the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave his place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.


