Subject: Unauthorized absence of doctors – joining thereof.


Government Order No. 368 -JK(HME) of 2022
Dated: 03 -06-2022

WHEREAS, the Director, Health Services, Jammu vide communication No. DHSJ/Es-3/Notice/2904 dated 23.12.2020, had intimated that among others, following doctors were absent from duties un-authorizedly from the dates mentioned against each:-

AND WHEREAS, the Director, Health Services, Jammu had served notices to these doctors, wherein, an opportunity was given to them to resume their duties immediately, otherwise disciplinary action shall be initiated against them as warranted under rules;

AND WHEREAS, Director Health Services, Jammu has intimated that Dr. Mohd. Tariq Chouhan, Dr. Sunil Kumar Bhat and Dr. Vivek Sharma, Medical Officers



have completed their super specialist courses and shown their willingness to resume their duties;

AND WHEREAS, in pursuance to the notice served to Dr. Karuna Wazir and Dr. Arjun Singh by the Director, Health Services, Jammu, both the doctors have shown their willingness to resume their duties;

AND WHEREAS, the case of these doctors were examined in the Department and in the interest of patient care, it has been decided that the doctors who have submitted their joining report in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu/Administrative Department in compliance to the notices served upon them, be allowed to resume their duties, subject to the condition that these doctors are/were not involved in any subversive activities as well as not employed in any other Government/private sector during the said period, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services Jammu, from the doctor concerned, besides, the period of their unauthorized absence shall be decided separately;

NOW THEREFORE, sanction is hereby accorded to allow the following Medical doctors to re-join in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu to resume their duties, with prospective effect, subject to the condition that they were not involved in any subversive activities as well as were not employed in any other Government/private sector during the said period, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctors:-
