Subject:- Settlement of period of unauthorized/undecided period in respect of Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit (Retired) Assistant Surgeon.

WHEREAS, Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit (Retired), was appointed as Assistant Surgeon in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No. 654-HME of 1982 dated 07.10.1982 and submitted his joining report in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu on 18.10.1982 and was posted at District Hospital, Poonch;

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor was selected for undergoing M.Ch course at Institute of Medical Sciences, Banaras Hindu University and was relieved on 16.01.1990 from Government Medical College, Srinagar with the directions to report his parent department after completion of said course;

AND WHEREAS, after Completion of his M.Ch course, Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit was relieved from IMS Banaras Hindu University on 08.01.1993. However, due to prevailing condition in the valley at that time, Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit couldn't join back and instead joined in Resident Commission, New Delhi on 14-01-1993. However, thereafter the said doctor remained unauthorizedly absent w.e.f July 1994 to January 2000;

AND WHEREAS, the instant case has already been examined in consultation with Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department (Chairman, Departmental Designated Committee), and the department while taking a considerate view in the matter, decided to treat the period of unauthorized absence in respect of Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit w.e.f July 1994 to January 2000, as leave whatever kind due except study leave and remaining period of short fall be treated as Dies Non, subject to the condition that he shall submit an affidavit duly authenticated by 1st

Class Judicial Magistrate to the effect that he was not involved in any activity contravening the Service Rules;

AND WHEREAS, the Health & Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 446-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 17.06.2021, accorded sanction to treat the period of unauthorized absence in respect of Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit w.e.f July 1994 to January 2000, as leave whatever kind due except study leave and remaining period of short fall be treated as "Dies-Non" subject to the condition that he shall submit an affidavit duly authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate to the effect that he was not involved in any activity contravening the Service Rules;

AND WHEREAS, the Principal Resident Commissioner, UT JK, New Delhi vide communication dated 13.10.2021 has requested for settlement of another higher study period w.e.f 1/1990 to 12/1992;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department had already constituted Departmental Committee for examining such cases vide Government Order No. 511-HME of 2018 dated 13.09.2018 read with Government Order No. 726-HME of 2018 dated 21.12.2018 & Government Order No. 479-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 08.07.2021. Later on the Health and Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 749-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 30.11.2021, re-constituted the Departmental Committee to be headed by Director Finance, H&ME Department for examining the cases of doctors or any officer/official of sub-ordinate office related to unauthorized absence/ overstay on deputation/ study leave or any other case of similar nature;

AND WHEREAS, the case of Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit (Retired) Assistant Surgeon, among others was placed before the Departmental Designated Committee for examination, wherein after series of meetings held on 10-01-2022 & 04.04.2022 deliberated upon the matter and recommended as under:-

"The Committee recommend to treat the period of unauthorized absence w.e.f 1/1990 to 12/1992 in favour of Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit, Medical Officer as "Dies Non" by taking administrative decision in the matter."

Now therefore, the Department while taking considerate view in the matter as per recommendations of the Committee accords sanction to treat the period of unauthorized absence w.e.f 1/1990 to 12/1992 in favour of Dr. Satish Kumar Pandit, Medical Officer as "Dies Non."


