

**Government Order No: 394-JK(HME) of 2022
Dated: 08-06-2022**

WHEREAS, the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, vide Government Order No. 559-JK(GAD) of 2020 dated 14-05-2020, constituted Accelerated Recruitment Committee (ARC) for coordinating the referral of all vacancies existing for direct recruitment at Class-IV level;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the issuance of aforesaid Government Order, the Health and Medical Department, vide O.M. No. HD/Coord/57/2019 dated 19-05-2020, forwarded the indent of **1879** Class-IV vacancies of its subordinate departments of the Health and Medical Education Department under different nomenclatures to the General Administration Department (Accelerated Recruitment Committee) for further referral to the J&K Services Selection Board for selection of suitable candidates;

AND WHEREAS, out of **1879** Class-IV vacancies, the Accelerated Recruitment Committee recommended only **1499 Class-IV vacancies** for referral to the J&K Services Selection Board for making selection and the Committee did not clear/recommend **380** Class-IV vacancies for referral for various reasons;

AND WHEREAS, on the recommendations of the Accelerated Recruitment Committee, **1499** Class-IV vacancies of Health & Medical Education Department with the following organization wise & category wise breakup, were referred by the General Administration Department to the J&K Services Selection Board for making selection of eligible candidates:-

AND WHEREAS, the General Administration Department, vide communication No.GAD/MTG0RBIV/63/2021-09-GAD dated 19.10.2021, forwarded a copy of select list of Class-IV posts as recommended by the J&K Services Selection Board vide their communication No. SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/7103-11 dated 18-10-2021, to the Health and Medical Education Department for further

necessary action pertaining to **798 recommended candidates**, excluding **(07)** seven candidates in whose case recommendations have been kept withheld **(Total 805 candidates)**. AND WHEREAS, it has been further conveyed by the General Administration Department that the appointment order in respect of the selected candidates shall be issued by the respective appointing authorities as per the standard terms and conditions already issued from time to time by the Government including the following additional conditions:-

- The appointment order of the selected candidates shall be issued by the respective appointing authorities only after the receipt of the verification of Character and Antecedents from the CID in terms of Government Order 528-JK(GAD) of 2021 dated 21.06.2021 as amended from time to time.
- All these appointments shall be made in terms of the Jammu & Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 notified vide S.O. 192 of 2020 dated 17.06.2020.
- The cadres/Department allocated by the appointing authority/SSB shall not be changed under any circumstances by any authority/Department.

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- d. The appointment shall be cancelled ab-initio, if it is found that the candidate is having higher qualification than the prescribed one at any stage later on, he/she shall also be liable for criminal prosecution.
- e. All the appointment orders shall be issued subject to the outcome of any petition/(s) pending in any competent Court/Tribunal etc.

AND WHEREAS, although the Class-IV vacancies were referred to the General Administration Department with the Organisation wise breakup alongwith the nomenclature/terminology, which these posts carry in the Health & Medical Education Department, the Accelerated Recruitment Committee/General Administration Department referred these posts on whole as Class-IV posts, without mentioning the Organisations & their specific nomenclature/ terminology, to the Services Selection Board for advertisement and selection;

AND WHEREAS, after receiving the selection list, the Health and Medical Education Department, conducted a detailed exercise, as per the details indicated hereunder, for allocation of selected candidates among the Organisations of the Department, proportionate to their Class-IV vacancies, on the basis of the referral made to the J&K Services Selection Board:-



AND WHEREAS, in terms of Government Order No.528-JK(GAD) of 2021 dated 21.06.2021, the appointment orders in respect of the candidates, as selected by the Recruiting Agencies, are to be issued only once a satisfactory verification report of their character & antecedents is received from the concerned quarters;

AND WHEREAS, Out of **798** candidates, the Health & Medical Education Department has received verification reports from the concerned Deputy Commissioners in respect of only **789** candidates and issued formal appointment orders in their favour on receipt of provisional verification report from the Deputy Commissioners. Besides, the CID Verification in respect of the remaining 09 candidates is still awaited from the concerned Deputy Commissioners;

AND WHEREAS, the appointment of the selected candidates shall be governed, subject to the following conditions:-

- A. The appointment of the above candidates shall be strictly governed by the conditions laid down in the J&K Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 notified vide S.O. 192 dated 17.06.2020.

- B. The appointee(s) shall submit their joining reports physically to their concerned HOD of the Organization indicated against each within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of this order and in case of failure of any appointee to join within the stipulated period, his/her appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without any further notice.
- C. The appointee(s) shall be allowed to join by the concerned Head of Departments(HODs)/Drawing and Disbursing Officers(DDOs) only on production of the following certificates in original:-
- i. Academic Qualification Certificates.
 - ii. Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate.
 - iii. Health Certificate issued by the Standing Medical Board.
 - iv. Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
 - v. Certificates from the District Industries Centre(DIC) and District Employment & Counseling Centre to the effect that no loan under the self employment scheme has been taken by the appointee.
 - vi. Relevant category certificate(s), (in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories).
 - vii. Any other certificates/documents as required under rules/norms.
- D. The provisions for probation, pay & allowances and fixed tenure of five years/seven years on initial engagement of the appointees shall be governed in terms of the J&K Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 notified vide S.O. 192 dated 17.06.2020.
- E. The appointees shall give an undertaking duly attested by the First Class Judicial Magistrate in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that:-
- i. he/she shall abide by all the terms & conditions as laid down in this appointment order.
 - ii. he/she shall not be eligible for transfer for whatsoever reason during the temporary service of five (05) years and in case of candidates who are Residents of Backward Area, adjoining Line of Actual Control or International Border, he/she shall serve in such areas for a period of not less than seven (07) years.
 - iii. he/she shall be liable for action as warranted under rules for violating any of the laid down conditions as indicated in the appointment order.
- F. The inter-se-seniority of the appointees shall be drawn in accordance with the merit secured by these appointees in the selection list prepared by the J&K Services Selection Board.




- G. The appointment of the candidates shall be subject to outcome of the writ petition (s), if any, pending before any Competent Court/Tribunal etc.
- H. The cadres/Department allocated by the appointing authority/SSB shall not be changed under any circumstances by any authority/Department.
- I. The appointment shall be cancelled ab-initio, if it is found that the candidate is having higher qualification than the prescribed one at any stage later on and he/she shall also be liable for criminal prosecution.

AND WHEREAS, the Deputy Commissioners, Rajouri and Shopian vide their communications dated 12/5/2022 and 25-02-2022 have intimated as under:-

- a. **Deputy Commissioner, Rajouri:** An Adverse report has been received from Criminal Investigation Department regarding verification of Character and Antecedents in respect of Ghulam Rasool S/o Gulzar Hussain R/o W.No. 7, Mangota Hariwali Tehsil Thannamandi District Rajouri, who was appointed as Class-IV in Health and Medical Education Department and presently posted as CSC Thannamandi. The fact of the case is that the above named individual was involved in case FIR No. 237/213 u/s 341,307,382,147,148,149,323 IPC of P/S Thannamandi.
- b. **Deputy Commissioner, Shopian:** The Subject namely Shahid Ashraf S/o Mohammad Ashraf Malik R/o Malik Mohalla Memender Tehsil and District Shopian selected as Class-IV in Divisional Cadre Kashmir figuring at Serial No. 296 is involved in case FIR No. 231/2020 U/S 452.379.506 IPC of Police Station Shopian and case is presently under investigation.

AND WHEREAS, the appointment orders in favour of Ghulam Rasool S/o Gulzar Hussain R/o W.No. 7, Mangota Hariwali Tehsil Thannamandi District Rajouri and Shahid Ashraf S/o Mohammad Ashraf Malik R/o Malik Mohalla Memender Tehsil and District Shopian were issued by the Health and Medical Education Department after receiving the provisional security clearance from the Deputy Commissioner Rajouri vide letter No. DCR/2021-22/Estt/1468-69 dated 21-10-2021 and Deputy Commissioner, Shopian vide letter No. DCS/Estt/SM/21/739 dated 23-10-2021 respectively;

AND WHEREAS, as per appointment orders, the name of Mr. Ghulam Rasool S/o Gulzar Hussain R/o W.No. 7, Mangota Hariwali Tehsil Thannamandi District Rajouri fall in the Government Order No. 669 –JK(HME) of 2021 dated 22-10-2021 at S.No. 356 and Mr. Shahid Ashraf S/o Mohammad Ashraf Malik R/o Malik Mohalla Memender Tehsil and District Shopian in the Government Order No. 674-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 24-10-2021 at S.No. 15;



Now, therefore, keeping in view of the adverse CID report as received from the Deputy Commissioners, Rajouri and Shopian, sanction is hereby accorded to the cancellation of appointment of following two Class-IV Employees ab-initio as per the details indicated against each:-
