Subject:- Settlement of period of unauthorized/undecided period in respect of Miss Rekha Sharma, FMPHW.

WHEREAS, Miss Rekha Sharma, was appointed as FMPHW in the Family Welfare Department vide Order No. 215 of 2016 dated 31.03.2016 and submitted her joining report in Directorate of General Family Welfare, Maternal Child Health & Immunization J&K on 05.04.2016 and was posted at Sub Centre Ranthal Block Kalakoot Raj. The said official remained unauthorized absence w.e.f 01.12.2016 to 12.09.2021 as she was suffering from Schizophrenia;

AND WHEREAS, as per Medical Board Certificate issued by Standing Medical Board, Government Medical College, Jammu vide No. GMC/MBC-3603/R/174 dated 17.02.2021, the official was suffering from Psychosis (Schizophrenia). It was also reported by District Mental Health Officer, Rajouri, vide No. DMHPO/R/2020-21/22 dated 12.09.2020 that the official was under treatment w.e.f. 01.12.2016 to 12.09.2020 and thereafter the concerned official joined in the office of CMO Rajouri on 13.09.2020;

AND WHEREAS, the Directorate General Family Welfare, Maternal Child Health & Immunization J&K has forwarded the case of Miss Rekha Sharma regarding settlement of period of authorized/unauthorized absence/acceptance of rejoining w.e.f. 01.12.2016 to 12.09.2020 to the Administrative Department;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department had already constituted Departmental Committee for examining such cases vide Government Order No. 511-HME of 2018 dated 13.09.2018 read with Government Order No. 726-HME of 2018 dated 21.12.2018 & Government

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

Order No. 479-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 08.07.2021. Later on the Health and Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 749-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 30.11.2021, re-constituted the Departmental Committee to be headed by Director Finance, H&ME Department for examining the cases of doctors or any officer/official of sub-ordinate office related to unauthorized absence/ overstay on deputation/ study leave or any other case of similar nature;


AND WHEREAS, the case of Miss Rekha Sharma, FMPHW, among others was placed before the Departmental Designated Committee for examination, wherein after series of meetings held on 10-01-2022 & 04.04.2022 deliberated upon the matter and recommended as under:-

- i. The Committee recommends to accept rejoining in favour of Miss Rekha Sharma FMPHW notionally w.e.f. 10.09.2020 and monetarily with effect from the date the concerned official is posted and resumes duties at the place of posting.
- ii. The Committee recommend to treat the period of unauthorized absence w.e.f. 01.12.2016 to 12.09.2020 in favour of Miss Rekha Sharma, FMPHW as leave whatever kind due and balance period be treated as Dies-Non, subject to the condition that the said official was not involved in any subversive activities as well as she was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Director General, Health & Family Welfare, J&K from the concerned official.
- iii. Besides, the concerned official shall be warned not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.

Now therefore, the Department while taking considerate view in the matter as per recommendations of the Committee & in the interest of patient care, accords sanction as under:-

- i. to accept rejoining in favour of Miss Rekha Sharma FMPHW notionally w.e.f. 10.09.2020 and monetarily with effect from the date the concerned official is posted and resumes duties at the place of posting.
- ii. to treat the period of unauthorized absence w.e.f. 01.12.2016 to 12.09.2020 in favour of Miss Rekha Sharma, FMPHW as leave whatever kind due and balance period be treated as Dies-Non, subject to the condition that the said official was not involved in any subversive



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activities as well as she was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Director General, Health & Family Welfare, J&K from the concerned official.

Besides, the concerned official is **warned** not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.


