Subject:- Settlement of period of unauthorized/undecided period in respect of Dr. Javid Ahmad Bhat, Medical Officer.

WHEREAS, Dr. Javid Ahmad Bhat was appointed as Medical Officer in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No. 857 - HME of 1985 dated 16.11.1985;

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor while working as Registrar in Government Medical College, Srinagar proceeded on one month earned leave w.e.f 07-08-1995 and after expiry of the leave he did not reported back to his duties as a result of which his assignment as Registrar was terminated w.e.f 05-09-1995 and was relieved by Principal Government Medical College, Srinagar in absentia to Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir. The doctor after being relieved from Government Medical College, Srinagar did not report in Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir and continued to be on un-authorized absence w.e.f 06-09-1995. Thereafter the doctor on 25-01-1999 submitted an application in Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir requesting therein he may be allowed to join his duties;

AND WHEREAS, the application of the doctor was submitted to Administrative department by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir vide letter No: -Es-3/1-3721/1252 dated:-08 07-2000;

AND WHEREAS, in response Administrative Department vide Government Order No: 854-HME of 2000 dated 27-11-2000 allowed the doctor to rejoin as fresh appointee as Assistant Surgeon for all practical purposes and was posted at District Hospital, Kargil, with the directions to join within 21 days, failing which his appointment shall be deemed to have

been cancelled. However, the doctor failed to join at District Hospital, Kargil;



AND WHEREAS, the doctor was thereafter appointed as B. Grade Ortho vide Government Order No. 657-HME of 2001 dated 17-09-2001 and was posted at District Hospital Budgam. The doctor as per records again failed to comply the order, as during the period he was undergoing Sr. Residency in SKIMS Medical College Bemina and preferred to continue there, however later on the doctor came to be appointed as Professor in SKIMS Medical College, Srinagar and has now requested for settlement of his period w.e.f. September/1995 to July/1999;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department had already constituted Departmental Committee for examining such cases vide Government Order No. 511-HME of 2018 dated 13.09.2018 read with Government Order No. 726-HME of 2018 dated 21.12.2018 & Government Order No. 479-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 08.07.2021. Later on the Health and Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 749-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 30.11.2021, re-constituted the Departmental Committee to be headed by Director Finance, H&ME Department for examining the cases of doctors or any officer/official of sub-ordinate office related to unauthorized absence/ overstay on deputation/ study leave or any other case of similar nature;

AND WHEREAS, the case of Dr. Javid Ahmad Bhat, Medical Officer, among others was placed before the Departmental Designated Committee for examination, wherein after series of meetings held on 10-01-2022 & 04.04.2022 deliberated upon the matter and recommended as under:-

"The committee observed that the case of Dr. Javid Ahmad Bhat stands previously examined/settled repeatedly but the concerned doctor has not shown compliance to Government Orders from time to time but preferred to remain unauthorizedly absent from the year 1995 onwards. As such his case doesn't merit any consideration at this point of time and hence rejected".

Now therefore, the case of Dr Javid Ahmad Bhat, Medical Officer was re-examined in the department and was found devoid of merits, hence his claim is rejected and no period of his service can be



considered in Health and Medical Education Department when he preferred to remain unauthorizedly absent from the year 1995 onwards.


