Subject: Initiation of RDA against Sh. Ghulam Ahmad Malik, the then Block Medical Officer, Mandi, Poonch.

Government Order No. 474- JK(HME) of 2022
Dated: 01-07.2022

WHEREAS, vide O.M.No. GAD(Vig)30-RDA/2017 dated 06.04.2017 General Administration Department requested for initiation of Regular Departmental Action against Dr. Ghulam Ahmad Malik, the then Block Medical Officer, Mandi, Poonch in accordance with J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956 on the recommendation of Vigilance Organization, J&K (now ACB);

AND WHEREAS, vide memorandum dated 01.04.2019, chargesheet was served to the alleged officer namely Dr. Ghulam Ahmad Malik, the then Block Medical Officer, Mandi, Poonch in terms of Rule 33 of the Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956;



AND WHEREAS, the alleged officer furnished his reply, wherein he has denied the charges leveled against him;

AND WHEREAS, vide Government Order No. 556-HME of 2019 dated 14.06.2019, Dr. Renu Sharma, the then Deputy Director Health Services (HQ) Jammu (now retired as I/C Director, Health Services, Jammu) was appointed as Inquiry Officer to conduct enquiry into charges framed against Sh. Ghulam Ahmad Malik, the then BMO Mandi Poonch on the basis of preliminary enquiry conducted by the vigilance organization, J&K (now ACB);

AND WHEREAS, the Inquiry Officer vide letter No. DHS/J/Griev/13877 dated 26.12.2019 furnished the enquiry report, stating therein that the allegation of misusing official position & accumulating huge wealth by misappropriating government funds does not seem to be based on facts, however, different agencies has also investigated the case in detail. So far as departmental issue is concerned, there is poor maintenance of records and codal formalities not observed in making purchases which can be termed as procedural lapse;

AND WHEREAS, vide this Department's letter dated 23.01.2020, 14.05.2020 and 07.04.2021, certain clarifications were sought from the Director Health Services, Jammu;

AND WHEREAS, Director, Health Services, Jammu vide Letter No. DHS/J/Accts/Gen/426 dated:-28-04-2022 has stated that drugs have been purchased from open market from time to time by then BMO Mandi Dr. Gh. Ahmed Malik only after the approval of Committee Members of Rogi Kalyan Smiti headed by the then Hon'ble MLA being Chairman. Due to non-availability of fair



price shop in District Poonch, all the medicines purchased from open market, were of emergency nature under NRHM schemes probably utilized during emergency deliveries, sudden accidents and epidemics in the area. Under these exigencies that Life being the priority, the codal formalities could not be completed and the purchases seem to be made in a hush-hush manner thereby violating the codal provisions;

Now, therefore, in terms of Rule 30 (i) of J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956, sanction is hereby accorded to censure Dr. Ghulam Ahmed Malik, the then BMO, Mandi, Poonch for violating the codal formalities under NRHM Scheme in the Medical Block Mandi poonch.


