Sanction is, hereby, accorded to the grant of provisional NOC/ permission in favour of Phoenix Paramedical College Pulwama to the enhancement of seats in **General Nursing & Midwifery (Diploma Course)**, for the session 2021-2022 as per the following intake capacity. Besides the course of Medical Assistant and sanitary Inspector are revoked with immediate effect.

The Provisional No Objection Certificate shall be granted subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The approval is subject to the fulfillment of provisions laid down in the J&K Paramedical Council, Act, 2014.
2. No capitation fee will be charged by the Institute.
3. The permission shall be subject to any policy on the subject, which the Government may sanction in future for regulation of these Institutes.
4. Eligibility of candidates for admission to the above Courses shall be made on merit basis as per the provisions laid down by the Government from time to time through J&K Board of Professional Entrance Examination (BoPEE).





5. The J&K Paramedical Council shall conduct inspection of the institute, periodically, to monitor and assess the adequacy of infrastructure in relation to the number of trainees.
6. An amount of Rs. 5000/- per trainee per session be charged by the Institute on account of providing hospital facility and the amount so received be utilized for Hospital Development fund of the Hospital to which the institute is attached.
7. For any lapse on the part of student/ students resulting in loss/ damage to equipment/chemical etc. The Institute shall be responsible for it. An undertaking to this effect be executed by the management of the institution with the Medical Superintendent of the Hospital.
8. The J&K Paramedical Council shall conduct examination of the trainees on the same pattern as in case of trainees of AMT/ANMT Schools in the UT of J&K.
