Subject: Re-validation/ Release of un-spent funds under Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Setting up of Microbiology Laboratory – Procurement of ICP-MS and LCMS-MS & GCMS-MS & LCMC-MS for Public Health Laboratories at Jammu & Srinagar" during the year 2022-23.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the re-validation/release of Rs. 42.84 lakhs (Rupees Forty Two lakh and Eighty Four Thousand) only, unspent balance of 2021-22 under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme, **"Setting up of Microbiology Laboratory – Procurement of ICP-MS and LCMS-MS & GCMS-MS & LCMC-MS for Public Health Laboratories at Jammu & Srinagar"** in favour of State Drug Controller, Drugs and Food Control Organization, J&K for its utilization during the current financial year 2022-23 towards the approved components of the scheme.

The re-validation/release of funds shall be subject to the following conditions:-

1. The expenditure shall be made strictly according to the classification under which funds have been authorized by the Finance Department.
2. Treasury Officers shall not entertain bill without complete classification under which funds have been authorized by the Finance Department.
3. Drawing and Disbursing Officer (DDO) shall complete all codal formalities before presentation of bills at the Treasury.
4. Treasury Officers shall not allow parking or drawl of funds in the Civil Deposit without the prior concurrence of the Finance Department.
5. The State Drug Controller, Drugs and Food Control Organization, J&K shall send status report about the scheme in terms of physical and financial progress made during the current financial year.
6. The State Drugs Controller, Drugs and Food Control Organization, J&K shall send the Utilization Certificate (UC) of the funds as early as possible and positively before 31-03-2023 to Govt. of India under intimation to this department.
7. All the sanctions/ approvals and clearances shall be in place before drawl of money from the treasury.
8. Director Finance, H&ME Department shall vouchsafe the availability of funds on BEAMS Portal and according release the funds to the concerned.
9. The State Drugs Controller, Drugs and Food Control Organization, J&K shall incur expenditure strictly as per the guideline of the scheme and the conditions laid down in the sanction letter of the concerned ministry of Government of India.


