Subject: - Settlement of period of unauthorized/undecided period in respect of Dr. Samiah Yousuf, Medical Officer.

WHEREAS, Dr. Samiah Yousuf was appointed as Medical Officer vide Government Order No. 132-HME of 2014 dated 04.03.2014;

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor while posted at SDH Chadoora approached Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir with an application requesting therein for permission to appear in NEET PG-2018 and the case was submitted to the Administrative Department;

AND WHEREAS, the Administrative Department vide communication No. HD/Gaz/Gen/12/2018 dated 17.04.2018, conveyed NOC in favour of the aforesaid doctor alongwith others for appearing in counseling of NEET;

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor approached Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir with an application stating therein that she has been selected for PG in Microbiology in SKIMS Soura and has requested for grant of study leave in her favour and Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir submitted the case to the Administrative Department;

AND WHEREAS, accordingly the Health & Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 421-HME of 2018 dated 16.07.2018 accorded sanction to the grant of one year study leave in favour of the aforesaid doctor for undergoing PG in Microbiology at SKIMS Soura, Srinagar w.e.f. 01.06.2018. However, remaining two years of study leave w.e.f. 01.06.2019 to 01.06.2021 was not sanctioned due to unknown

reasons and the period spent by the doctor beyond the spell of study leave w.e.f. 01.06.2021 to 06.01.2022;

AND WHEREAS, Director, Health Services, Kashmir has forwarded her case regarding settlement period of unauthorized absence w.e.f. 01.06.2019 to 06.01.2022 to the Administrative Department for issuance of appropriate necessary instructions;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department had already constituted Departmental Committee for examining such cases vide Government Order No. 511-HME of 2018 dated 13.09.2018 read with Government Order No. 726-HME of 2018 dated 21.12.2018 & Government Order No. 479-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 08.07.2021. Later on the Health and Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 749-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 30.11.2021, re-constituted the Departmental Committee to be headed by Director Finance, H&ME Department for examining the cases of doctors or any officer/official of sub-ordinate office related to unauthorized absence/ overstay on deputation/ study leave or any other case of similar nature;

AND WHEREAS, the case of Dr. Samiah Yousuf, Medical Officer, among others was placed before the Departmental Designated Committee for examination/deliberations wherein the committee in its meeting held on 05-07-2022 recommended as under:-

The committee recommends to treat the period of undergoing PG in Microbiology in SKIMS Soura, Srinagar w.e.f. 01.06.2019 to 06.01.2022 as leave whatever kind due including extra ordinary leave without allowances subject to the conditions that the concerned doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as she was not employed in any Government/Private Sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor. Besides, the concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.

Now therefore, the Department while taking considerate view in the matter as per recommendations of the Committee, accords sanction to treat the period of undergoing PG in Microbiology in SKIMS Soura, Srinagar w.e.f. 01.06.2019 to 06.01.2022 as leave whatever kind due

including extra ordinary leave without allowances subject to the conditions that the concerned doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as she was not employed in any Government/Private Sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor.

Besides, the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.
