**Government Order No: 550 (JK) HME of 2022
Dated: 27-07-2022**

Sanction is, hereby, accorded to the grant of provisional NOC in favour, of Green Valley Institute of Paramedical Sciences Dhobwan, Tangmarg, Kashmir, for enhancement of seats in **MMPHW** and **General Nursing & Midwifery (Diploma Course)**, as per the following intake capacity

S.NO	Name of the course	Present intake capacity	New recommended intake	Total Intake capacity
01	MMPHW	50	30 seats merged to GNM	20 seats
02	General Nursing Midwifery	25	30 seats merged from MMPHW and 20 seats enhanced in GNM	75 seats

This shall be however based on the following stipulations:-

1. That the said Institute shall upgrade conference rooms, nutrition Lab, Library Canteen facilities as per the norms.
2. That the said Institute shall deposited Rs, 50000 (Fifty Thousand) yearly Affiliation fee.
3. That the said Institute shall upgrade the dimensions of the Classrooms, Library, Laboratories, etc as per the directions of the committee.
4. All other requisite up-gradation as per the directions made by the team.



5. That Institute shall take steps to upkeep the building as per the directions passed.

In addition to the above, the Provisional No Objection Certificate shall be granted subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The approval is subject to the fulfillment of provisions laid down in the J&K Paramedical Council, Act, 2014.
2. No capitation fee will be charged by the Institute.
3. The permission shall be subject to any policy on the subject, which the Government may sanction in future for regulation of these Institutes.
4. Eligibility of candidates for admission to the above Courses shall be made on merit basis as per the provisions laid down by the Government from time to time through J&K Board of Professional Entrance Examination (BoPEE).
5. The J&K Paramedical Council shall conduct inspection of the institute, periodically, to monitor and assess the adequacy of infrastructure in relation to the number of trainees.
6. An amount of Rs. 5000/- per trainee per session be charged by the Institute on account of providing hospital facility and the amount so received be utilized for Hospital Development fund of the Hospital to which the institute is attached.
7. For any lapse on the part of student/ students resulting in loss/ damage to equipment/chemical etc. The Institute shall be responsible for it. An undertaking to this effect be executed by the management of the institution with the Medical Superintendent of the Hospital.
8. The J&K Paramedical Council shall conduct examination of the trainees on the same pattern as in case of trainees of AMT/ANMT Schools in the UT of J&K.


