2. The sanction shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (b) The leave during the period was duly sanctioned by the competent authority;
- (c) The doctor has submitted the final LTC claim on Form 3 within one month from the date of return journey after availing the LTC;
- (d) The other conditions for grant of this concession shall be same as laid down in J&K Civil Service (LTC) Rules, 2019;
- (e) This sanction shall be for the **Block 2020-23**.


