Subject:- Termination of Services of Dr. Sovia Anand, Casualty Medical Officer, Government Medical College Kathua.

Reference:- GMCK/Admn-I/2022-23/1090-1092 dated 26.07.2022 from Principal, Government Medical College, Kathua.

Government Order No. 680 - JK(HME) - 2022

WHEREAS, on the recommendation of the J&K, Public Service Commission, among others, Dr. Sovia Anand was appointed as Casualty Medical Officer in Government Medical College Kathua, vide Government Order No. 69-HME of 2019 dated 16.01.2019; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sovia Anand after joining her duties in Government Medical College, Kathua submitted an application on 01.11.2021 for grant of 30 days earned leave and without waiting for its formal sanction from the competent authority, proceeded on unauthorized leave w.e.f 13.08.2021; and

WHEREAS, the Principal, Government Medical College, Kathua vide letter dated 08.11.2021, intimated Dr. Sovia Anand regarding cancellation of her leave and directed her to join her duties within three (03) days positively. However, the doctor didn't report back to her duties ever after expiry of three (3) days; and

WHEREAS, Principal, Government Medical College, Kathua vide communication 30.11.2021, served show-cause notice to Dr. Sovia Anand with the direction to resume her duties but she failed to join her duties even after the considerable time period; and

WHEREAS, the case was examined in the Health & Medical Education Department in terms of rules in vogue and it was decided to provide last and final opportunity to Dr. Sovia Anand to resume her duties as Casualty Medical Officer in Government Medical College, Kathua; and

WHEREAS, vide this Department's letter dated 14.06.2022, Principal, Government Medical College, Kathua was requested to serve final notice through print media as well as at residential address of Dr. Sovia Anand, asking her to resume her duties within a period of seven (7) days positively, with the stipulation in the notice that in case she fails to join with the prescribed time, action as warranted under Article 128 of the J&K Civil Service Regulations shall be initiated against her; and

WHEREAS, Principal, Government Medical College, Kathua vide communication dated 26.07.2022 informed that a final show cause notice was served to the absconding doctor, which was published in the newspapers viz Daily Excelsior, Young Bite, Kathua Kasari on 02.07.2022 with the directions to resume her duties within a period of one week, failing which necessary action as warranted under rules shall be initiated against her. However, she did not join her duties even after the lapse of stipulated time period; and

WHEREAS, the case has been examined in the Health & Medical Education Department in light Article 128 of the Jammu & Kashmir, Civil Service Regulations and it has been found that Dr. Sovia Anand had remained un-authorizedly absent from her duties and, therefore, she has lost her service in view of the import of Article 128 of the Jammu & Kashmir, Civil Service Regulation.

Now, therefore, the services of **Dr. Sovia Anand as Casualty Medical Officer, Government Medical College, Kathua,** are hereby terminated with immediate effect.
