Subject: Unauthorized absence of doctor – joining thereof.

Government Order No. 53 -JK(HME) of 2023
Dated: 20 .01.2023

WHEREAS, Dr. Sayma Samoon, was appointed as Medical Officer vide Government Order No. 132-HME of 2014 dated 04.03.2014 and deputed to GMC Srinagar on inter-cadre deputation;

AND WHEREAS, the doctor while on deputation to GMC, Srinagar, was selected for P.G in Anatomy at GMC, Srinagar and was subsequently relieved by the Director, Health Services, Kashmir vide Order No. Est-3/1-133/837-40 dated 16.06.2015, in pursuance to the approval of Administrative Department conveyed vide letter No. HD(Gaz)Gen-16/2015-II dated 08.06.2015, wherein, it was ordered that the study period will be treated as "**Dies-non**" in terms of Article 163 of J&K CSR Volume-I, read with SRO-514 of 1999;

AND WHEREAS, after completion of the PG period, the doctor concerned was not relieved by GMC authorities to the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir but retained her in the GMC Srinagar;


AND WHEREAS, the doctor concerned while working in GMC Srinagar was selected for Tutor/Demonstratorship in SKIMS Medical College and accordingly vide Order No. 04-AH of 2019 dated 10.04.2019, Government Medical College, Srinagar relieved the doctor concerned to report to Director, Health Services, Kashmir for her proper relieving to SKIMS Medical College Bemina;

AND WHEREAS, instead of joining in the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir, the doctor concerned joined Tutor/Demonstratorship at SKIMS Medical College at her own on the direction of the Hon'ble High Court passed vide its order dated 18.03.2019 in SWP No. 1930/2018 titled Dr. Sayma Samoon Vs State of J&K and others, the operative part of which is as under:-

"Let the respondent Government Medical College, allow the petitioner to take benefit of appointment by relieving her and in the event no such order is passed, Principal SKIMS Medical College Bemina, Srinagar shall accept the joining report".

AND WHEREAS, Registrar Academics SKIMS Medical College vide Order No. SKIMS/MC/Acad/3316-25 dated 04.08.2022, relieved Dr. Sayma Samoon from SKIMS Medical College-Hospital Bemina, Srinagar on 04.08.2022 and directed her to report to Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir for further duties;

AND WHEREAS, Director, Health Services, Kashmir vide communication No. Est-3/1-133/12334 dated 02.09.2022, has intimated that Dr.



Sayma Samoon, Medical Officer has submitted her joining report in the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir on 05.08.2022 after relieving from SKIMS Medical College, Bemina;

AND WHEREAS, Dr. Sayma Samoon, Medical Officer has shown her willingness to rejoin her duties back in the Health Department, therefore, the Government has taken a lenient view in her case and decided to accept her joining report.

NOW THEREFORE, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- a) accept the joining report of Dr. Sayma Samoon, Medical Officer (PG Anatomy) notionally w.e.f. 05.08.2022 and monetary with immediate effect, subject to following conditions:-
 - i. She was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any other Government/private sector during the said period, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir.
 - ii. The concerned doctor is warned not to leave her place of posting for any occasion whatsoever in future, without proper permission from the competent authority, failing which, disciplinary action in terms of Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services Regulations Volume-I shall be initiated against her without any further notice.
- b) The intervening period of her absence/Tutor/ Demonstrator in SKIMS Medical College, Bemina, Srinagar shall be decided by the Departmental Designated Committee separately.
