In continuation to Government Order No. 706-JK(HME) of 2022 dated 06-10-2022, sanction is hereby accorded to the advance drawal of Rs. 388.52 lakhs (Rupees Three Crore Eighty Eight Lakh & Fifty Two Thousands) Only, available under Capex Budget 2022-23 as matching UT Share for Centrally Sponsored Schemes "National Ayush Mission (NAM)" and "Strengthening of Drug Regulatory System in the State- Establishment of Modern Drug Testing Laboratory at Kathua" by Director, Ayush, J&K and State Drug Controller, Drug & Food Control Organization, J&K respectively for utilization of funds during the current financial year (2022-23) as per the following break-up:-

The advance drawal of funds shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. Director, Ayush, J&K and State Drug Controller, Drug & Food Control Organization, J&K shall furnish the physical and financial progress report every month to this Department, which shall be open to on the spot verification.
2. The funds shall be utilized for specific purpose after observing all codal procedures / formalities as per GFR 2017 including Administrative Approval and Technical Sanction from competent authority wherever required.
3. The HODs shall credit the drawal funds to the SNA of both the schemes and incur the expenditure as per the guidelines of the scheme.
4. Proper and transparent e-tendering process shall be adopted in the execution of works and purchase of material / supplies / equipments, if any.
5. There shall be no overlapping of funds from any other source and funds shall not be used for clearing any unauthorized liability.
6. All the sanctions/ approvals and clearances shall be in place before drawal of money from the treasury.

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7. The expenditure shall be incurred on admissible items only, as approved by the competent authority strictly as per the guidelines of the scheme and the conditions laid down by the concerned Ministry of Government of India.
8. Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department shall vouchsafe the availability of funds on BEAMS portal.
9. The UCs/ Red D.C accounts shall be furnished to the concerned quarters within the stipulated time.
10. The funds shall not be parked un-necessarily.
11. The funds shall not be available for re-appropriation/ diversion at any level.
12. The funds shall be debited as per the following account classification :


