


WHEREAS, Dr. Ranjan Kachru was appointed as Assistant Surgeon (now Medical Officer) in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No. 130-HME of 1984 dated 20.02.1984 and was posted at Allopathic Dispensary District Pulwama;

AND WHEREAS, the said doctor while posted at Allopathic Dispensary District Pulwama was selected for PG in Medicine at SMHS Hospital Srinagar vide order No. SS-3/4874-76 dated 11.07.1987 and was relieved vide MC order No. Es/Acad/PG/7841-7857 dated 25.10.1989. The doctor has pursued his PG course prior to migration;

AND WHEREAS, as reported by the Principal Resident Commissioner, UT of J&K vide communication dated 10.05.2022, the leave salary of the doctor for the unauthorized period of absence has not been paid w.e.f 01.01.1993 to 31.01.2000;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department had already constituted Departmental Committee for examining such cases vide Government Order No. 511-HME of 2018 dated 13.09.2018 read with Government Order No. 726-HME of 2018 dated 21.12.2018 & Government Order No. 479-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 08.07.2021. Later on the Health and Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 749-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 30.11.2021, re-constituted the Departmental Committee to be headed by Director Finance, H&ME Department for examining the cases of doctors or any officer/official of sub-ordinate office related to



unauthorized absence/ overstay on deputation/ study leave or any other case of similar nature;

AND WHEREAS, the case of Dr. Ranjan Kachroo, Medical Officer, among others was placed before the Departmental Designated Committee for examination/deliberations wherein the committee in its meeting held on 05-07-2022 recommended as under:-

"The committee recommends to treat the period of unauthorized absence in favour of Dr. Ranjan Kachru w.e.f. 01.01.1993 to 31.10.2000 as Dies Non."

Now therefore, the Department while taking considerate view in the matter as per recommendations of the Committee, accords sanction to treat the period of unauthorized absence in favour of Dr. Ranjan Kachru w.e.f. 01.01.1993 to 31.10.2000 as **Dies Non**, subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as he was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Principal Resident Commissioner, UT of Jammu & Kashmir.




