Government Order No. 101 -JK (HME) of 2024
Dated: 16-02-2024.

Whereas, an Essential Drug List for Government hospital of J&K was notified vide Notification No.01 of 2018 dated 31.07.2018 for the period 2016-2018;

Whereas, a revised Essential Drug List (EDL) was subsequently notified vide Government order No.619-HME of 2019 dated 03.07.2019 for its implementation in the Government hospitals of Jammu and Kashmir;

Whereas, revised Essential Drug List (EDL) was notified vide Government Order No.24-JK(HME) of 2022 dated 21.01.2022 for its implementation in the Government hospitals of Jammu and Kashmir in supersession of previous orders/notifications on the subject;

Whereas, Mission Director, NHM J&K proposed to increase the number of drugs and diagnostics at Health & Wellness Centers as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India and has also suggested to constitute a committee to examine and recommend the list of Free Drugs and Diagnostics for Health & Wellness Centers;

Whereas, the Department vide Government Order No.388-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 09.05.2023 constituted a committee for finalization of the list of free Drugs and Diagnostics to be made available at Heath and Wellness Centers, in line with recommendations of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India;

Whereas, the committee submitted its recommendations vide letter No.HME/DF/PS/2023-10 dated 17.07.2023 with regard to the number of Free drugs and diagnostics at Health & Wellness Centers;

Now, therefore, the department, upon acceptance of the recommendations of the committee and in supersession of all previous orders/notifications on the

subject, hereby notifies the list of free drugs and diagnostics forming as **Annexure A & B** to this Government order for its implementation in the Public Health Centres (PHCs) & Sub Centres (Health & Wellness Centres) of Jammu and Kashmir with immediate effect.






