**Subject:** Settlement of authorized/unauthorized absence period in favour of Dr. Naresh Chander Sharma, Consultant Gynaecologist.

**Government Order No. 1083 – JK (HME) of 2023**

**Dated: 21 .12.2023**

**WHEREAS,** Dr. Naresh Chander Sharma was initially appointed as Medical Officer vide Government Order No. 710-HME of 1997 dated 12.08.1997 and later on, he was appointed as Consultant Gynaecologist vide Government Order No. 595-HME of 2009 dated 31.12.2009;

**AND WHEREAS,** vide Government Order No. 77-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 29.01.2021, the doctor concerned was transferred from CHC Akhnoor to CHC Sunderbani, Rajouri, but he did not join there;

**AND WHEREAS,** the doctor concerned approached the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu by filling an application O.A No. 61/1383/2022 taking his health grounds of being suffering from serious chronic health problem i.e. lumbar Disc Prolapse at level of L4 to L5 with neurodeficit;

**AND WHEREAS,** vide Government Order No. 718- JK(HME) of 2021 dated 18.11.2021, the doctor concerned was posted at DH Samba;

**AND WHEREAS,** vide communication No. ES- 3/4800/1258 dated 16.06.2023, the Director, Health Services, Jammu has forwarded his case for settlement of his unauthorized absence period w.e.f. 31.01.2021 to 17.11.2021;

**AND WHEREAS,** the case was placed before the Departmental Designated Committee in its meeting held on 03.08.2023, who deliberated upon the case and recommended as under:

***"To treat the period of absence of the doctor w.e.f. 31.01.2021 to 17.11.2021 as leave, whatever kind is due to him which shall be subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as he was not employed in any Govt/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is***

***pending against him, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by 1st class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor.***

***Besides, the doctor shall be warned not to leave his place of posting on unauthorized basis in future for which departmental actions shall be initiated against him without any notice"***

**NOW, THEREFORE,** on the recommendation of the Departmental Designated Committee, sanction is, hereby, accorded to treat the period of absence **w.e.f. 31.01.2021 to 17.11.2021** in favour of Dr. Naresh Chander Sharma, Consultant Gynaecologist as **"leave, whatever kind is due to him"**, subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as he was not employed in any Govt/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by 1st class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor. Besides, the doctor is warned not to leave his place of posting on unauthorized basis in future for which departmental actions shall be initiated against him without any notice.
