WHEREAS, vide Government Order No. 02- JK(HME) of 2024 dated 01.01.2024, Dr. Gopal Sharma, Consultant Surgeon was recalled from Government Medical College, Rajouri and posted at CHC Katra;

AND WHEREAS, Principal, GMC, Rajouri vide communication No. GMCR/2023-24/3135 dated 09.01.2024 intimated the concerned doctor was deputed to GMC Rajouri as Assistant Professor and requested for his retention at GMC Rajouri, until a permanent appointment to the post of Assistant Professor is made through the J&K PSC. The urgency of this retention is due to shortage of specialized medical practitioners within the institution;

AND WHEREAS, Dr. Gopal Sharma had undergone specialized CISP training and had assumed the role of a teaching faculty/consultant for DNB students in the Department of General Surgery at GMC Rajouri;

AND WHEREAS, a meticulous examination of the aforementioned appeal within the department illuminated a critical aspect that two candidates have been allocated DNB seats within the Department of General Surgery at GMC Rajouri. Any alteration in the supervisory guide at this juncture is poised to have a profound impact on the educational and professional trajectory of the students currently undergoing the DNB program at GMC Rajouri.

AND WHEREAS, GMC Rajouri, stands as a nascent institution in its early stages of establishment and as such necessitates a measured and deliberate approach to staff augmentation, recognizing the importance of a well-qualified and proficient team in fostering the academic and operational excellence of the institution;
