Subject: Selection list of Class-IV posts of Union Territory/Divisional/ District Cadre of J&K-appointment thereof (Phase-I).

Government Order No. 19 -JK (HME) of 2024
Dated: 15 .01.2024

WHEREAS, the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, vide Government Order No. 559-JK(GAD) of 2020 dated 14-05-2020, had constituted Accelerated Recruitment Committee (ARC) for coordinating the referral of all vacancies existing for direct recruitment at Class-IV level;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department, vide O.M. No. HD/Coord/57/2019 dated 19-05-2020, forwarded the details of **1879** Class-IV vacancies under different nomenclatures to the General Administration Department (Accelerated Recruitment Committee) for clearance, so that these vacancies may be referred to the J&K Services Selection Board for selection of suitable candidates;

AND WHEREAS, out of **1879** Class-IV vacancies, the Accelerated Recruitment Committee had cleared only **1499 Class-IV vacancies** for referral to the J&K Services Selection Board for making selection and the remaining **380** Class-IV vacancies were not cleared by the aforesaid committee, as the grade of these vacancies was different from the Class-IV(MTS) vacancies and on the recommendations of the Accelerated Recruitment Committee, the Health and Medical Education Department had referred **1499** Class-IV vacancies to the General Administration Department for onwards referral to the J&K Services Selection Board for making selection of eligible candidates;

AND WHEREAS, the General Administration Department, vide communication No.GAD/MTG0RBIV/63/2021-09-GAD dated 19.10.2021 forwarded selection list of Class-IV posts (Phase-I) as recommended by the J&K Services Selection Board vide their communication No. SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/7103-11 dated 18-10-2021 to the Health and Medical Education Department for further necessary action in respect of **798 recommended candidates**, excluding **(07)** seven candidates in whose cases recommendations were kept withheld (**Total 805 candidates**) with the following conditions in addition to the standard terms and conditions already issued from time to time:-

- i. The appointment order of the selected candidates shall be issued by the respective appointing authorities only after the receipt of the verification of Character and Antecedents from the CID in terms of Government Order 528-JK(GAD) of 2021 dated 21.06.2021 as amended from time to time.
- ii. All these appointments shall be made in terms of the Jammu & Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 notified vide S.O. 192 of 2020 dated 17.06.2020.

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- iii. The cadres/Department allocated by the appointing authority/SSB shall not be changed under any circumstances by any authority/Department.
- iv. The appointment shall be cancelled ab-initio, if it is found that the candidate is having higher qualification than the prescribed one at any stage later on, he/she shall also be liable for criminal prosecution.
- v. All the appointment orders shall be issued subject to the outcome of any petition/(s) pending in any competent Court/Tribunal etc.

AND WHEREAS, simultaneously, the selection list was forwarded to all the Deputy Commissioners by the General Administration Department for submission of provisional Character and Antecedents verification report in respect of the selected candidates to the concerned Departments for issuance of formal appointment order in their favour in terms of Government Order No.528-JK(GAD) of 2021 dated 21.06.2021 and in pursuance of the provisional Character and Antecedents verification report from concerned Deputy Commissioners;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department has issued formal appointment orders from time to time in respect of 794 candidates out of 798 candidates in whose respect the clear recommendations were received. After issuance of appointment orders in respect of the aforesaid candidates, the Department has received the CID verification from Deputy Commissioner Shopian in respect of one more candidate namely **Sh. Shahid Ahmad, S/o Sh. Mohd Shafi Malik, R/o Jan Mohalla, Hergam, Shopian** vide letter No. DMS/Veri/23/795-96 dated 29.05.2023 after a gap of almost two (02) years and after expiry of the validity of the selection panel as stipulated in the Circular instructions issued by the General Administration Department vide Circular No. 38-JK(GAD) of 2020 dated 24.12.2020 for a period of one year from the date the select list is sent to the requisitioning authority;

AND WHEREAS, on receipt of the CID verification from the Deputy Commissioner, Shopian, the issue was examined in the Department and accordingly was taken up with General Administration Department vide U.O No. HD-Cord/226/2023-02 dated 31.10.2023 for seeking grant of extension of validity of selection list of Class-IV(MTS) in favour of Sh. Shahid Ahmad, S/o Sh. Mohd Shafi Malik R/o Jan Mohalla, Hergam, Shopian for considering his appointment as Class-IV/MTS in H&ME Department in relaxation of Rule 14(5) of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Decentralization and Recruitment Rules, 2010 as the provisional verification report of his character and antecedents has been received after expiry of the validity of selection list from the District Magistrate Shopian vide letter dated 29.05.2023;

AND WHEREAS, the General Administration Department vide U.O. No. GAD-MTGORBIV/140/2023(7282734) dated 23.12.2023, conveyed the approval of the competent authority (Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor) as under:-

"In relaxation of Rule 14 (5) of the J&K Civil Services (Decentralization) Rules, 2010, sanction is hereby accorded to the extension in the validity of select list for appointment of Sh. Shahid Ahmad, S/o Sh. Mohd Shafi Malik R/o Jan Mohalla, Hergam, Shopian as Class-IV (MTS) in Health & Medical Education Department recommended by the J&K Services Selection Board vide No. SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/7103-11 dated 18-10-2021 beyond the date of its expiry i.e. 17-10-2022 upto 15-01-2024"

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NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the approval of the competent authority conveyed by the General Administration Department vide aforementioned U.O and on the basis of the recommendations of the J&K Services Selection Board duly forwarded by the General Administration Department, sanction is hereby accorded to the temporary appointment of following candidate (in respect of whom recommendation has been released by the Service Selection Board) as well as CID verification from CID Organization as Class-IV in the Pay Level SL-1(14800-47100) notionally with effect from 22-10-2021 in the Health and Medical Education Department as per the detail indicated as below:-

However, the appointment of the aforesaid candidate shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- A. The appointee shall submit his joining report physically to the concerned HOD of the Organization indicated against him within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of this order and in case of failure of any appointee to join within the stipulated period; his appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without any further notice.
- B. The appointee shall be allowed to join by the concerned Head of Department (HOD) only on production of the following certificates in original:-
 - i. *Academic Qualification Certificates.*
 - ii. *Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate.*
 - iii. *Health Certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer.*
 - iv. *Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.*
 - v. *That if the candidate has taken loan for self-employment from DIC/Employment Department, to be ascertained from the District Industries Centre (DIC) and District Employment and Counseling Centre of the domicile District, he/she shall relinquish the proprietorship of unit /enterprise and also stakes, if any, in such self employment Unit / enterprise before joining the Government Service. He/she shall be required to repay the entire loan liability in suitable EMIs to be worked out by the DDO concerned from his/her salary. DDO concerned shall obtain an affidavit from the concerned appointee regarding both relinquishment of proprietorship and stakes, if any, in such a self-employment unit/enterprise and recovery to be made and also personally monitor its recovery*
 - vi. *Relevant category certificate(s), (in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories).*
 - vii. *Any other certificates/documents as required under rules/norms.*
- C. The appointee shall give an undertaking duly attested by the First Class Judicial Magistrate in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that:-
 - i. *if on verification from the concerned issuing authorities, the qualification certificate/reserved category certificate/experience certificate (wherever applicable) is found forged, false or fake, the appointee shall have no claim for appointment.*

- ii. *salary of the appointee shall not be drawn and disbursed to him/her unless and until the satisfactory report/ genuineness of the certificates in respect of Condition C (i) is received.*
- iii. *The appointment of the candidates shall be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" as notified vide SRO-400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009.*
- iv. *appointee shall abide by all the terms & conditions as laid down in this appointment order.*
- v. *appointee have no criminal records and also is not facing any criminal proceedings in any Court of Law.*
- vi. *appointee shall be liable for action as warranted under rules for violating any of the laid down conditions as indicated in the appointment order.*
- D. The inter-se-seniority of the appointee shall be drawn in accordance with the merit secured by the appointee in the selection list prepared by the J&K Services Selection Board.
- E. The appointee shall be on probation for a period of two (02) Years.
- F. The appointment of the candidate shall be subject to outcome of the writ petition (s), if any, pending before any Competent Court/Tribunal etc.
- G. The cadre/Department allocated by the J&K Services Selection Board/ appointing authority shall not be changed under any circumstances by any authority/Department.
- H. The appointment shall be cancelled ab-initio, if it is found that the candidate is having higher qualification than the prescribed one at any stage later on and he/she shall also be liable for criminal prosecution.
