Subject: Settlement of authorized/unauthorized absence period in favour of Dr. Neelam Rani, Medical Officer.

Government Order No. 56 – JK (HME) of 2024
Dated: 23 .01.2024

WHEREAS, Dr. Neelam Rani was appointed as Medical Officer vide Government Order No. 464-HME of 2005 dated 01.08.2005;

AND WHEREAS, the aforementioned doctor, while working in Government Medical College, Jammu applied for the tenure post of Demonstratorship in the Department of Pharmacology in Government Medical College, Jammu;

AND WHEREAS, vide letter No. Es-3/244/3070 dated 04.11.2019, Director, Health Services, Jammu forwarded the application form submitted by Dr. Neelam Rani, Medical Officer for the above said tenure post to the Administrative Department as the doctor had sufficient years of services at her credit as per rules in vogue;

AND WHEREAS, the doctor was appointed as Demonstrator in the discipline of Pharmacology in Government Medical College, Jammu vide Order No. 570 of 2019 dated 28.11.2019 and she joined the same in light of the interim direction passed by the Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) No. 4220/2019 titled Neelam Rani Vs UT of J&K and others, the operative part of which is as under:-

"Meanwhile, notwithstanding that the petitioner is not relieved by the respondent Nos. 1 & 2, respondent No. 3-Principal and Dean, Government Medical College, Jammu shall allow the petitioner to

join as Demonstrator and in the meantime respondent Nos.1 & 2 shall process the case for relieving the petitioner".

AND WHEREAS, vide No. DHSJ/ES-3/5244/1945 dated 04.08.2023, Director, Health Services, Jammu has stated that the case filed by the doctor in the Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) No. 4220/2019 titled Neelam Rani Vs UT of J&K and others has been transferred to the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu in T.A./2970/2020 and is still pending;

AND WHEREAS, after being relieved from the Government Medical College, Jammu vide Order No. GMCJ/PF/ES-1/1894 dated 18.03.2023, the aforesaid doctor submitted her joining in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu;

AND WHEREAS, Director Health Services, Jammu accepted the joining report of Dr. Neelam Rani, Medical Officer, in anticipation of favourable action in her favour, in view of Court Orders and vide letter No. DHSJ/ES-3/877 dated 26.05.2023, submitted the proposal for her posting to the Administrative Department;

AND WHEREAS, before posting the doctor against an available post, the Department placed the matter for settlement of period of unauthorized absence/undergoing Demonstratorship from GMC Jammu before the Departmental Designated Committee and the Committee in its meeting held on 12.10.2023 deliberated upon the case and recommended as under:-

"May treat the period of undergoing Demonstratorship in the Department of Pharmacology in GMC, Jammu w.e.f. 28.11.2019 to 18.03.2023 in favour of doctor as "leave whatever kind due other than study leave and remaining period, if any, as 'Dies-non'."

NOW, THEREFORE, on the recommendation of the Departmental Designated Committee, sanction is hereby accorded to treat the period of undergoing Demonstratorship in the Department of Pharmacology in Government Medical College, Jammu **w.e.f.**

28.11.2019 to 18.03.2023 in favour of Dr. Neelam Rani, Medical Officer as "leave whatever kind due other than study leave and remaining period, if any, as 'Dies-non', subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as she was not employed in any Govt/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by 1st class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor.

Besides, the doctor is warned not to leave her place of posting on unauthorized basis in future for which departmental actions shall be initiated against her without any notice.
