**Subject:** Application of Dr. Mir G. R. Wali, Lecturer, Orthopaedics in Government Medical College, Srinagar for grant of permission for Fellowship in Orthopaedics Oncology and Joint Reconstruction at Royal National Orthopaedics Hospital, London, UK.

**WHEREAS**, the Health & Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 350-HME of 2018 dated 06.06.2018, among others, appointed Dr. Mir G. R. Wali as Lecturer in the Department of Orthopaedics in Government Medical College, Srinagar; and

**WHEREAS**, Principal, Government Medical College, Srinagar vide communication dated 25.05.2022 forwarded a copy of application put-forth by Dr. Mir G. R. Wali, Lecturer (Orthopaedics) in Government Medical College, Srinagar duly endorsed by HoD Orthopaedics, wherein he submitted that he has been offered a Fellowship in Orthopaedic Oncology and Joint Reconstruction at Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital, London, UK for a period of 12 months starting July 2022. The Principal, Government Medical College, Srinagar requested for grant of necessary permission in his favour; and

**WHEREAS**, the case was examined in the Department and, accordingly, vide this Department's letter dated 27.06.2022, Principal, Government Medical College, Srinagar was requested to furnish requisite information related to the case.

**WHEREAS**, in response, Principal, Government Medical College, Srinagar vide communication dated 05.08.2022 stated that Dr. Mir G. R. Wali, left the station on 01.08.2022 to undergo Fellowship in Orthopaedic Oncology and Joint Reconstruction at Royal National



Orthopaedics Hospital, London, UK as intimated by HoD Orthopaedics, Government Medical College, Srinagar; and

**WHEREAS**, the case was examined in the Health and Medical Education Department in terms of Circular No. 49-JK(GAD) of 2022 dated 07.2.2022 issued by General Administration Department and it was found that Dr. Mir G. R. Wali has rendered only 4 Years, 01 Month & 26 days' service till 01.08.2022 i.e. the date on which the doctor left the station. Thus, Dr. G. R. Wali is not eligible for availing study leave.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the request of Dr. Mir G. R. Wali, Lecturer (Orthopaedics) in Government Medical College, Srinagar for sanction of study leave for one-year Fellowship in Orthopaedic Oncology and Joint Reconstruction at Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital, London, UK has been found devoid of merit and is, accordingly, rejected.
