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**Subject: Appointment/Postings of Medical Officers (Allopathic) in the J&K Health & Family Welfare (Gazetted) Service - Operation of waiting list, thereof.**

WHEREAS, vide communication No. PSC/Exam/MO(Allo)/2022 dated 03.10.2022, the J&K Public Service Commission forwarded wait list in respect of 90 candidates for the post of Medical Officers as per following breakup:-

AND WHEREAS, it was also conveyed by the J&K Public Service Commission that the name of Dr. Murtaza Ahmad Ganie S/o Ab Aziz Ganie, from main list shall be deemed to have been withdrawn from the communication No. PSC/Exam/MO(Allo)/2022 dated 12.09.2022 as he has not reported for document verification before the commission;

AND WHEREAS, the H&ME Department vide Government Order No. 930-JK(HME) of 2022 dated 21.12.2022 & Government Order No. 137-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 13.02.2023 had accorded sanction to the cancellation of appointments in respect of 108 Medical Officers (main list) with the following breakup who were

appointed vide Government Order No. 748-JK(HME) of 2022 dated 25.10.2022 & Government Order No. 890-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 12.12.2023 but failed to join at their respective place of postings upto the last date of joining:-

AND WHEREAS, during the process of registration under "Employee Verification System (EVS)", some of the selected candidates (31 out of main select list & 10 out of wait list) either didn't approach the H&ME department or approached but didn't upload information/details on EVS;

AND WHEREAS, vide this department's communication No. HD-Gaz0Gen/47/2021 dated 10.04.2023, the issue was taken up with the J&K PSC for withdrawal of their recommendations in respect of aforesaid candidates as Medical Officer in Health and Medical Education Department and also sought their consent for operation of waiting list against these accrued vacancies out of the main select list;

AND WHEREAS, the J&K PSC vide communication No. PSC/DR/Exam/MO(Allo)/2022 dated 08.05.2023 consented to the operation of waiting list in case a need arises;

AND WHEREAS, consequent upon cancellation of appointment of aforesaid Medical Officers and in order to operate waiting list of newly selected Medical Officers in a time bound manner, notice was issued to 90 selectee Medical Officers (i.e. OM=82 & RBA=08 figuring in the waiting list) for submission of their email address & mobile number in the Health and Medical Education Department, Civil Secretariat, Srinagar/Jammu for registration under "Employee Verification System (EVS)" within a period of 07 days positively from the date of issuance of notice issued vide No. HD-Gaz0Gen/964/2022-02 dated 28.12.2022, No. HD-Gaz0Gen/332/2023-02 dated 19.04.2023 & No. HD-Gaz0Gen/47/2021-02 dated 24.05.2023 in terms of Circular No. 18-JK (GAD) of 2022 dated 20.05.2022 issued by the General Administration Department;

AND WHEREAS, on receipt of verification reports in respect of 75 candidates (72 wait list + 3 main list), the Health & Medical Education Department issued appointment/posting orders in their favour vide Government Order No. 218-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 10.03.2023, Government Order No. 241-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 24.03.2023, Government Order No. 401-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 12.05.2023, Government Order No. 450-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 30.05.2023,

Government Order No. 514-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 20.06.2023 & Government Order No. 560-JK(HME) of 2023 dated 13.07.2023;

AND WHEREAS, the department has now received verification reports from the Criminal Investigation Department, J&K in respect of two (02) more candidates figuring in the Waiting list of Medical Officers;

Now, THEREFORE, as recommended by the J&K Public Service Commission, sanction is, hereby, accorded to the temporary appointment and posting of following two (02) candidates (wait list) in respect of whom verification reports have been received from J&K Criminal Investigation Department as Medical Officers in the Jammu and Kashmir Health and Family Welfare (Gazetted) Service in the Pay Level-9 (Rs. 52700-166700) with immediate effect:-




However, this shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- A) The appointee(s) shall submit their joining reports physically to their concerned Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDOs) within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of this order and in case of failure of any appointee to join within the stipulated period, his/her appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without any further notice.
- B) The appointee(s) shall be allowed to join by the concerned Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDOs) only on production of the following certificates in original:-
  - i. Academic/Technical Qualification Certificates.
  - ii. Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate.
  - iii. Health Certificate issued by the Standing Medical Board.
  - iv. Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
  - v. That if the candidate has taken loan for self-employment from DIC/Employment Department to be ascertained from the District Industries

Centre (DIC) and District Employment & Counseling Centre of the domicile District, he/she shall relinquish the proprietorship of unit/enterprise and also stakes, if any, in such self-employment unit/enterprise before joining the Government service. He/She shall be required to repay the entire loan liability in suitable EMIs to be worked out by the DDO concerned from his/her salary. DDO concerned shall obtain an affidavit from the concerned appointee regarding both relinquishment of proprietorship and stakes, if any, in such a self employment unit/enterprise and recovery to be made and also personally monitor its recovery."

- vi. Relevant category certificate(s), (in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories).
  - vii. Any other certificates/documents as required under rules/norms.
- C). The appointee(s) shall give an undertaking duly attested by the First Class Judicial Magistrate in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that, if on verification of his/her Qualification/Date of Birth/Reserved Category Certificates from the concerned issuing authorities are found/proved to be fake or forged, the appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without further notice and the legal action as warranted under rules shall be initiated against the candidate.
- D) The salary of the appointees shall not be drawn and disbursed to him/her unless the satisfactory reports in respect of (B) above are received in his/her favour.
- E) The appointees shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- F) The appointment of the candidates shall be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" as notified vide SRO-400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009.
- G) The inter-se-seniority of the appointees shall be drawn in accordance with the merit secured by these appointees in the selection list prepared by the J&K Public Service Commission.
- H) The appointee(s) shall not be allowed to continue with PG/ tenures of Senior Residency/ Jr. Residency/ Registrarship/ Demonstratorship/ Tutorship/ Fellowship etc. and they will have only one choice either to opt for appointment or opt out and go for such higher study/training course, in which case candidates from the waiting list will be considered for appointment.
- I) The appointment of the candidates shall be subject to outcome of the writ petition (s), if any, pending before any Competent Court of Law.
- J) The appointees shall give an undertaking duly attested by the First Class Judicial Magistrate in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that:-
- i. she shall abide by all the terms & conditions as laid down in this appointment order.
  - ii. she is not undergoing any higher study/training course viz. PG/tenures of Senior Residency/Jr. Residency/ Registrarship/ Demonstratorship/Tutorship/Fellowship etc and in case after joining as Medical Officer, it comes to the notice of the department that appointee is on the rolls of any Medical College (Government/Private) within or outside the UT of J&K, she shall be liable for criminal proceedings under relevant



provisions of law and their appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio.

- iii. She shall not claim for any kind of leave, permission or exception to continue with her higher study/training course viz. PG/tenures of Senior Residency/ Jr. Residency/ Registrarship/ Demonstratorship/ Tutorship/Fellowship etc.
- iv. She shall be liable for action as warranted under rules for violating any of the laid down conditions in this appointment order.

It is further ordered that:-

All the concerned Chief Medical Officers / Medical Superintendents/Block Medical Officers/DDO's shall ensure that appointee Medical Officer shall attend duties as per her specific place of posting without any change/alteration in their postings by way of deployments or internal arrangements failing which disciplinary proceedings shall be initiated against such concerned Chief Medical Officers/ Medical Superintendents/ Block Medical Officers/ DDO's including appointee Medical Officer.

All the concerned Drawing & Disbursing Officers of Health & Family Welfare Department shall submit categoric report/details of appointees who fail to join physically within the stipulated time period immediately after expiry of 21 days to the Administrative Department concerned Directorates. Besides, attendance alongwith documentary evidence in respect of the appointees, who joined physically, shall be submitted at the end of every month to the Administrative Department concerned Directorates and in case any discrepancy of facts is brought to the notice of Administrative Department, action as warranted under rules, shall be taken against such DDO(s).

The Director SKIMS Soura, Srinagar, Principal, SKIMS Medical College, Bemina, Srinagar and all the concerned Principals of Government Medical College(s) of UT of J&K, shall ensure that appointee Medical Officer opts for only one full time assignment i.e either to continue with her higher study/training course or alternatively on the appointed post of Medical Officer, to avoid parallel engagements.





