In terms of Rule 6 (5) of the J&K Civil Services (Medical Attendance-cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990, ex-post facto sanction is hereby accorded to the reimbursement of the medical expenses incurred by Sh. Yogesh Kumar, Basic Health Worker on the treatment of his wife Smt. Pooja Sharma at Fortis Hospital, Mohali, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. reimbursement of charges shall be restricted to items / procedures admissible under rules during the period of hospitalization only and cost thereof shall be restricted to the extent of rates as applicable for such items / procedures at PGI Chandigarh.
- ii. all relevant medical bills / vouchers shall be got verified from relevant Medical Authority of the hospital where from treatment has been taken.
- iii. essentiality certificate on Form 2 issued by the hospital authorities shall be obtained and kept on record.
- iv. Dependence of the patient on the official shall be established under rules before reimbursement of the claim.
- v. certificate from Competent Medical Authority (Director Health Services / Principal GMC / Other) shall be obtained to establish the genuineness of the treatment availed in the said hospital.
- vi. before making the reimbursement of the expenses to the beneficiary, Director Health Services, Jammu shall ascertain the reasons for delay caused in the settlement of the case and place the report thereof on record.
